24. Trinity: Mystery with a Message

Dear brothers and sisters,

This weekend, we celebrate the life of Holy Trinity and Father's day. The Trinity is a mystery to be lived. When we gaze into this divine mystery we don't find confusion, we find communion. We don't find fear, we find faith. And most of all, we find a message of hope as in our families.

i. A Perfect Relationship: God reveals Himself not as solitary, but as an eternal relationship; a communion of love. This isn't a dry doctrine-it's a living hope. Because if God Himself exists as a communion of persons, then we too are made for relationship, unity, and love. "God is love." (1 Jn 4:8) This means: We were created out of love, by love, and for love.

ii. Love Is Never Alone: We are never meant to be alone. Just as the Son is always with the Father, and the Spirit proceeds from their love, so too God desires to draw us into His own divine life. "I will not leave you orphaned [Jn. 14:18]. "We'll dwell with him." (Jn 14:23). This exists in good Christian families. This is our hope: God does not remain far off. Through Christ and the Spirit, the Trinity moves toward us, entering into our struggles, our homes, our hearts, just a good father does.

iii. Hope to a Divided World: In a world torn by conflict, racism, division, and fear, the Trinity gives us a blueprint for unity without uniformity. The Father is not the Son, the Son is not the Spirit - yet they are One. Hope comes from knowing that true unity is possible, when we live not in rivalry, but in mutual love and mission.

Let's shape our families, Not domination, but dialogue. Not isolation, but communion. Not self-interest, but shared mission. Happy Father's day! Msgr. Xavier

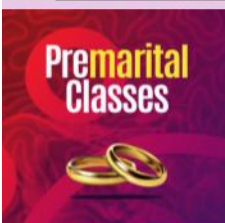

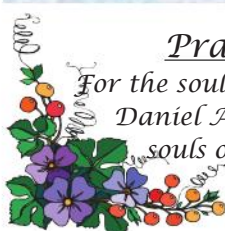

The Difference Between Sacrament Preparation & Faith Formation

Sacrament Preparation:

Purpose: To prepare individuals to receive a specific sacrament (such as Baptism, First Communion, Confirmation, Reconciliation, or Marriage).

Focus: Understanding the meaning and importance of the specific sacrament. Learning the rites, prayers and traditions associated with it. Spiritual and moral readiness to receive the sacrament.



Faith Formation

Purpose: To nurture and deepen a person's lifelong relationship with God and understanding of the faith.

Focus: Broad teaching of Christian doctrine, Scripture, prayer, moral living, and Church teachings. Encouraging a personal and communal life of faith. Supporting spiritual growth over time.

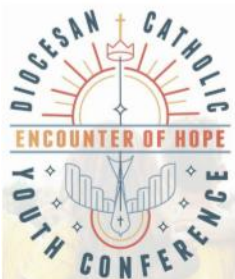

24. Trinidad: El Misterio con un Mensaje

Queridos Hermanos,

Este fin de semana, honramos a la Santísima Trinidad y día del padre! En la Trinidad, encontramos comunión sobre la confusión, fe sobre el miedo y, lo más importante, esperanza. Dios es nuestros padre nos da un mensaje. ¿Qué es ese mensaje?

i. Una relación perfecta: Dios se revela a sí mismo como una relación eterna, una comunión de amor. Esta esperanza viva significa que hemos sido creados por amor, por amor y para el amor. Como se dice en 1 Juan 4:8, "Dios es amor".

ii. El amor nunca está solo: En momentos de soledad o desánimo, recuerda: no estás solo. Así como el Hijo está siempre con el Padre, y el Espíritu procede de su amor, Dios desea atraernos a su vida divina. Jesús nos asegura: "No os dejaré huérfanos" (Juan 14:18).

iii. Esperanza para un mundo dividido: En un mundo marcado por el conflicto y la división, la Trinidad ofrece un modelo para la unidad sin uniformidad. El Padre, el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo son distintos pero uno, enseñándonos que la verdadera unidad es posible a través del amor mutuo y la misión compartida.
