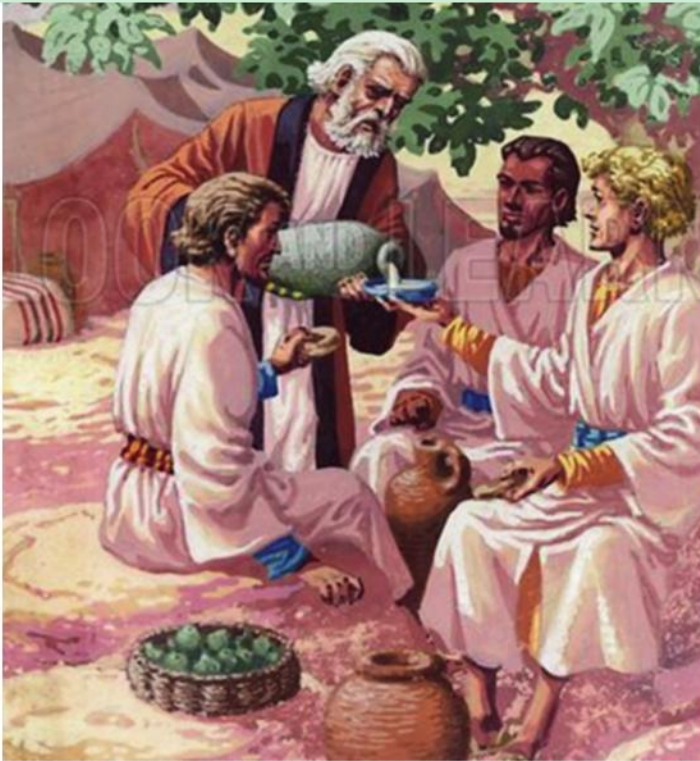

29. Our Hospitality Gives Hope

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Hospitality is a human virtue - a gesture of kindness or generosity. Hospitality opens the door to divine presence. When we welcome others, especially with faith and love, we welcome God, and through that encounter, we give hope.

A couple getting married invited "whoever wants to celebrate with us" to their small-town reception. Among the guests was a man who had been hitchhiking across the state. He ate, danced, and even gave a toast. Later, the groom said, "We still don't know who he was, but he gave the best toast of the night—and we think he blessed our marriage." Stranger's blessing!

Abraham sees three strangers near his tent and runs to serve them. His hospitality is generous, immediate, and deeply reverent. The result? Received a divine blessing; a promise is fulfilled: "By this time next year, Sarah will have a son." Hospitality to strangers brings blessings!

We also see two different types of Hospitality. Martha welcomes Jesus and serves Him, busily. Mary listened to Jesus attentively. Jesus affirms that Mary has chosen the better part, not because Martha was wrong, but because of her attentiveness to Jesus. Hospitality is about welcoming others with a godly heart.

St. Paul says, Christ in You is the Hope of Glory (Col. 1:24-28) when we receive the people around us as Christ would do, *we carry hope within*. Every time we open our hearts to others, we nourish the hope and give hope.

Christian hospitality isn't just about niceness—it's opening our homes, hearts, and churches to others sowing hope in them. "Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for by doing that some have entertained angels without knowing it." (Heb.13:2)

It provides a prime opportunity to lay the foundation for a holistic education for children.

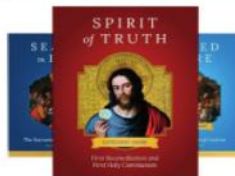

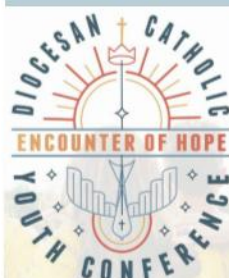

29. "Nuestra Hospitalidad Da Esperanza"

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

La hospitalidad es una virtud humana —un gesto de bondad o generosidad— que abre la puerta a la promesa y presencia divinas. Cuando recibimos a los demás con fe y amor, recibimos a Dios y damos esperanza.

Abraham ve a tres desconocidos y corre a servirles con una hospitalidad generosa y reverente. Como resultado, se hace una promesa divina: "El año que viene, Sara tendrá un hijo". La hospitalidad crea un espacio para que Dios actúe.

Vemos dos tipos de hospitalidad en Marta y María. Marta sirve activamente a Jesús, mientras que María escucha a sus pies. Jesús alaba a María no porque Marta esté equivocada, sino para mostrar que la verdadera hospitalidad se centra en la atención a la presencia de Dios.

San Pablo dice: "Cristo en vosotros, esperanza de gloria" (Col. 1:27). Cuando recibimos a los demás como lo haría Cristo, llevamos y compartimos esperanza.

La hospitalidad cristiana no es mera bondad; es confianza en que Cristo puede estar presente en cada persona. Al abrir nuestros corazones, hogares e iglesias, especialmente a los pobres, solitarios y sufrientes, sembramos esperanza en ellos y en nosotros mismos. Como dice Hebreos 13:2: «No se olviden de la hospitalidad, porque por ella algunos, sin saberlo, hospedaron ángeles».

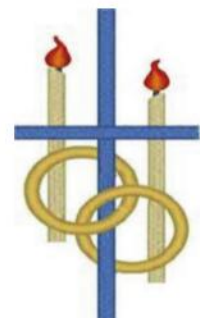
