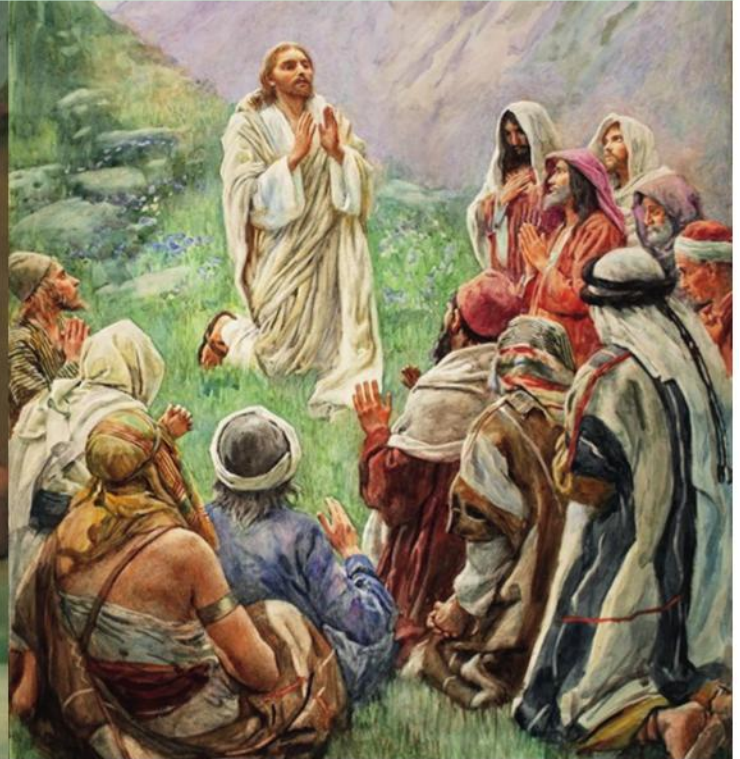

For formation in discernment: Let us pray that we might again learn how to discern, to know how to choose paths of life and reject everything that leads us away from Christ and the Gospel.



30. Prayer Hopes; Hope Prays

Dear brothers and sisters,

There is a beautiful cycle between hope and prayer. Hope stirs us to pray; and prayer fills us with hope.

Abraham, the friend of God, pleaded for Sodom boldly, persistently and humbly, with hope in God's mercy. His hope gave him the courage to speak; to bargain! God didn't mind it; He was patient in listening to Abraham's prayer. Their mutual relationship led to their dialogue in prayer.

Prayer is more than making requests; it's a declaration of dependence and trust. A man goes to his friend's house at midnight with hope, trust and dependence that he would get a loaf of bread! It is rooted in relationship. With hope, we voice our trust, surrender our worries, to God and to one another. Persist in your relationship!

One of the greatest scientists, Galileo, gave this witness to his faith in God: "I can take my telescope and look millions of miles into space; but I can lay my telescope aside, go into my room and shut the door, get down on my knees in prayer, and I see more of heaven and get closer to God than by all the telescopes on earth".

St. Paul prayed for Thessalonians: "May God encourage your hearts and strengthen you in every good work and word" (2 Thess.2:17). He invited believers to support one another through intercession, recognizing the power in unified prayer. Our prayers become vessels of hope for others—offering comfort, affirmation, and spiritual encouragement.

Someone said, "The quickest way to get us on our feet is to get us on our knees." Let us pray for each other with hope that we may stand for Christ!

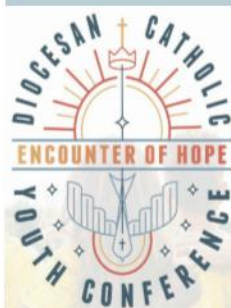

5 Powerful Ways [after a retreat] to Keep Your Heart on Fire for God

Is your heart on fire for God? Yes, after this "mountaintop experience" during the retreat, your heart is full of love & joy.
How to grow & glow in it!

1. Pray Daily: To keep your faith burning bright, start with the basics – prayer. Regular communication with Him will help keep the passion for Him burning. Even if you don't know how to pray, ask God to fill your heart with a desire and hunger for more of Him.

2. Read and meditate on God's Word. (Read the daily Mass readings) When you meditate the Word becomes alive in you. Remember the example of the Emmaus Disciples. (Lk. 24:32) Their hearts were burning within them. Read Psalm 1:2-3; and Rom. 10:17.

3. Serve Others: Whenever I serve others, I always get a joyful feeling inside. Join one of the ministries in the church. People go for mission trips and come back fully on fire. For God. Be the hands and feet of Jesus to set your heart on fire for God. When you follow Christ's example and serve other people, you will see God's love in action and it will stir your heart closer to God's. Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord. [Romans 12:11]

4. Fellowship with Others who are on fire for God. Surround yourself and fellowship with other believers. It is so important to our faith walk. Try to attend a weekly group through the church and always leave feeling fired up for God.

5. Share the good news to a non-believer everyday. Choose a different non-believer and make an effort to share your love for God. Thus, you will be rekindling your faith putting off your old self and taking up your new identity. Jesus fills your heart and sets on fire to glorify Him.

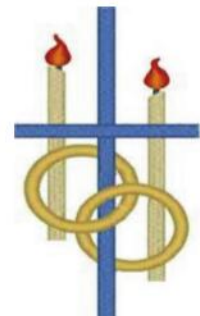
