31. Hoping in Hopeless Things!

Dear brothers and sisters,

Someone said, "Some people are so poor, all they have is money". Malcolm Forbes said, "He who dies with the most toys, wins." which is often used ironically or humorously to point out that material possessions are not ultimately important.

In the parable of the rich fool, Jesus exposes the tragic irony of a life consumed by false security. The rich man's fields yield an abundant harvest. He tears down his barns to build bigger ones; not to share, but to hoard. He hopes in his things - in possessions, control, comfort, and his self-sufficiency. Such is a vision for our "best lives". Jesus calls him "fool", not because he is rich, but because he placed his hope in hopeless things. Remember, "He who dies with the most toys..." still dies - and never takes his toys with him.

The rich neglected the spiritual richness that comes from a relationship with God. Their barn is full; but the soul is empty. True hope is found not in accumulating wealth but in being "rich toward God" - cultivating a relationship with God, living according to His will, and valuing spiritual over material wealth.

Someone said, "I have disposed of all my property; one thing more I wish I could give them, the faith in Jesus. If they had not that, even if I had given all the world, they would be poor." Jesus encourages us to examine our priorities and to invest in what truly matters - our relationship with God and the well-being of others.

A Christian's hope is found not in barns, but in bread broken and shared. It's found not in accumulation, but in generosity. Not in control, but in communion.

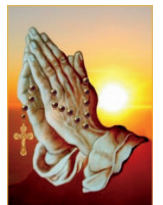

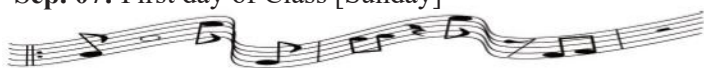

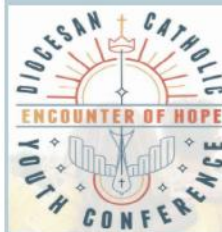

5 Powerful Ways [after a retreat] to Keep Your Heart on Fire for God

Is your heart on fire for God? Yes, after this "mountaintop experience" during the retreat, your heart is full of love & joy. How to grow & glow in it!

1. **Pray Daily:** To keep your faith burning bright, start with the basics – prayer. Regular communication with Him will help keep the passion for Him burning. Even if you don't know how to pray, ask God to fill your heart with a desire and hunger for more of Him.
2. **Read and meditate** on God's Word. (Read the daily Mass readings) When you meditate the Word becomes alive in you. Remember the example of the Emmaus Disciples. (Lk. 24:32) Their hearts were burning within them. Read Psalm 1:2-3; and Rom. 10:17.
3. **Serve Others:** Whenever I serve others, I always get a joyful feeling inside. Join one of the ministries in the church. People go for mission trips and come back fully on fire. For God. Be the hands and feet of Jesus to set your heart on fire for God. When you follow Christ's example and serve other people, you will see God's love in action and it will stir your heart closer to God's. Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord. [Romans 12:11]
4. **Fellowship with Others** who are on fire for God. Surround yourself and fellowship with other believers. It is so important to our faith walk. Try to attend a weekly group through the church and always leave feeling fired up for God.
5. **Share the good news** to a non-believer everyday. Choose a different non-believer and make an effort to share your love for God. Thus, you will be rekindling your faith putting off your old self and taking up your new identity. Jesus fills your heart and sets on fire to glorify Him.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

Alguien dijo: «Hay gente tan pobre que solo tiene dinero». Malcolm Forbes afirmó irónicamente: «Quien muere con más juguetes, gana», resaltando que las posesiones materiales no son lo más importante.

En la parábola del rico insensato, Jesús revela la trágica ironía de confiar en una falsa seguridad. El rico acumula su cosecha no para compartir, sino para guardar, esperando en sus bienes, autosuficiencia y control. Jesús lo llama "insensato", no por ser rico, sino por confiar en lo que no da esperanza. Recuerden: «Quien muere con más juguetes, muere, y no se lleva sus juguetes».

Este hombre descuidó la riqueza espiritual que surge de una relación con Dios. Tenía graneros llenos, pero el alma vacía. La verdadera esperanza está en ser "ricos para con Dios", viviendo conforme a su voluntad y valorando lo espiritual sobre lo material.

Alguien dijo: «Vendí todos mis bienes; una cosa más quisiera darles: la fe en Jesús. Sin ella, aunque tuvieran todo, serían pobres». Jesús nos llama a revisar nuestras prioridades y a invertir en lo que realmente importa: Dios y el prójimo.

La esperanza cristiana no está en los graneros, sino en el pan compartido; no en acumular, sino en ser generosos; no en el control, sino en la comunión.

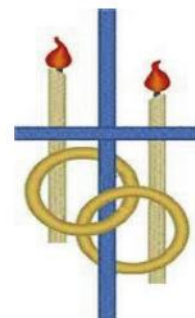
