33. Hope Amid Struggle and Division

Dear brothers and Sisters,

A little boy was playing outdoors and found a caterpillar, which his mother told him he could keep. He watched it every day; his mother said that it was going to go through a metamorphosis and become a butterfly. The boy watched as the caterpillar created its cocoon, and then until the butterfly emerged from the same cocoon and was thrilled. Struggle is good or good struggle!

All of us, and me as a priest, can empathize with the prophet Jeremiah, who suffers not because he did wrong, but because he dared to speak God's truth to power / authority. For challenging the injustices of his time, he is thrown into a cistern - a place of abandonment and hopelessness. And yet, it is *from* that pit that God's deliverance comes through an individual. God sees our suffering and sends help, often in ways we do not anticipate. Do you recall a few incidents? Those give us hope!

Surely, following Jesus will set us apart - straining relationships and place us at odds with the values of the world even within our families. But it is precisely in this refining fire that hope is born in the *saving love of Christ*. This is conviction, forged in the fire of God's call to grow in Him.

The author of Hebrews calls us to run with endurance, inspired by the "cloud of witnesses"; saints and prophets, even our parents and grandparents. The race is hard, and it involves shedding sins, facing discouragement, and enduring trials. But our eyes are on **Jesus**, who endured the cross for the joy set before Him. You and I are not alone. We are surrounded, supported, and strengthened by those who have walked the same path of faith. God is present and active, especially in the struggle.

All we have to say is "Lord, come to my aid", like the psalmist. Never give up! Division gives direction! You will find hope amid your struggles and divisions.

Pro-Life: Month 5 Fetal Development

This month marks the half-way point to birth, and the baby is very active. Sleep habits develop and his mother can feel him move and stretch, particularly when she is resting. He is big and strong enough to kick hard against the outside uterine wall and dent it. Up to now, although he swam with ease in his watery world, he was too small for her to detect because the wall of the uterus has little feeling. Babies born at this age have survived. 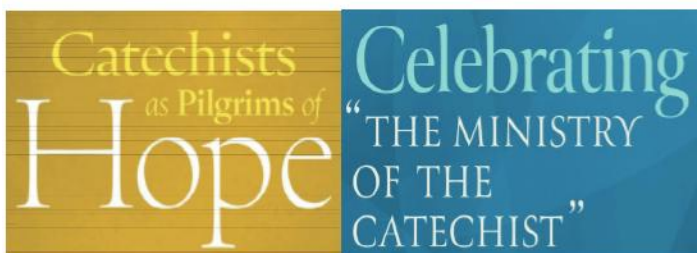

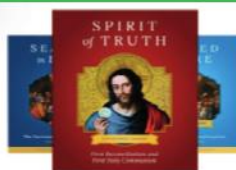
Jim Burns has written an article entitled "How to Pass Your Faith to Your Kids." (p. 41) He offers

6. Utilize media to launch discussions about God and the Christian life.
7. Have a plan for family devotional and prayer times.
8. Have fun with your kids.
9. Get involved in ministry together as a family.
10. Disciple and equip your kids.

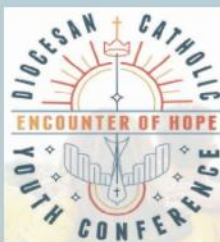

33. Esperanza en Medio de la Lucha y la División

Queridos hermanos y hermanas:

Vivir como cristianos es vivir en esperanza con valentía, aferrados a Dios aun cuando el mundo nos rechace. En medio del rechazo y la incompreensión, Dios no abandona a quienes esperan en Él.

Todos nosotros, y yo como sacerdote, podemos sentirnos como el profeta Jeremías, quien sufre no por haber obrado mal, sino porque se atrevió a decir la verdad de Dios al poder/la autoridad. Por desafiar las injusticias de su tiempo, es arrojado a una cisterna, un lugar de abandono y desesperanza. Y, sin embargo, es de ese pozo que la liberación de Dios llega a través de una persona. Dios ve nuestro sufrimiento y nos envía ayuda, a menudo de maneras que no anticipamos. ¿Recuerdan algunos incidentes?

Seguir a Jesús nos distingue, creando tensiones incluso en nuestras familias. Pero es en ese fuego donde nace la verdadera esperanza, enraizada en el amor de Cristo, no en la aprobación humana.

La carta a los Hebreos nos invita a perseverar, animados por la "nube de testigos"—santos, profetas y nuestros seres queridos. La carrera es difícil, pero con los ojos en Jesús, quien soportó la cruz, no estamos solos. Dios camina con nosotros.

Digamos como el salmista: "Señor, ven en mi ayuda". ¡No te rindas! ¡Ora con fervor! En medio de la lucha y división, hallarás esperanza. Bendiciones! - Mons. Xavier
