34. Hope in Fellowship or Familiarity?

Dear brothers and sisters,

There's a great difference between being in fellowship and being familiar with God. One transforms; the other make us take Him for granted. God is a fellowship within himself - three equal and distinct persons, Father, Son and Spirit. He invites and includes us in this fellowship.

Fellowship involves sharing in the grace of God, as well as a mutual commitment to spiritual growth and service. It involves meaningfully communing with God and connecting with others in a way that signifies a deeper and more intentional relationship built on shared beliefs, and mutual support. St. John says, "Our fellowship is with the Father and with His Son, Jesus Christ" (1 Jn.1:3). In the spiritual life, fellowship is cultivated in prayer, the sacraments daily - a spiritual discipline - entering through narrow door.

Familiarity, however, can be dangerous when it slips into complacency. It is knowing *about* God, using His name often, even doing religious things, but without the depth of obedience and awe. Jesus warns us, "Lord, Lord open the door for us... we ate and drank in His company! The Lord says, "I don't know you." (Mt 7:21 -23 & Lk13: 22-30). We think "God knows us" just because we've been around His house and received all the sacraments, while our hearts may be far from Him. These enter through a wide and popular door.

Think of the people of Nazareth. They knew Jesus as "the carpenter's son." They were *familiar* with Him, but didn't have true fellowship because they lacked faith (Mark 6:1-6). Familiarity blinded them to His glory.

Just two things to keep in mind: Live the grace of the sacraments fully - it's fellowship with God, that would lead to fellowship with others. So that our fellowship with God never becomes a ritual or routine but real and meaningful.

34. Esperanza en Comunión o Familiaridad?

Queridos hermanos y hermanas:

Hay una gran diferencia entre estar en comunión y estar familiarizado con Dios. Uno se transforma; el otro nos hace darlo por sentado. Dios es una comunión dentro de sí mismo: tres personas iguales y distintas, Padre, Hijo y Espíritu. Él nos invita e incluye en esta comunión, a través de sus Sacramentos.

La comunión es vivir los sacramentos de la gracia. Al recibirlos regularmente, el cristiano vive en un estado continuo de renovación e intimidad con Dios. Así, participamos en la comunión divina y nos fortalecemos en vocaciones y estados de vida específicos. La comunión se cultiva en la oración, los sacramentos diarios -una disciplina espiritual- entrando por la puerta estrecha.

La familiaridad es cuando un cristiano no vive los sacramentos, sabe acerca de Dios, pero su relación se vuelve esporádica y autosuficiente, basada en las propias emociones, hábitos de oración o esfuerzo moral en lugar de la gracia prometida por Dios. Sin vida sacramental y participación eucarística, deja el alma espiritualmente separada de la plena comunión con Dios y la Iglesia. Estos entran por puerta ancha y popular. Por lo tanto, el Señor dice: "No te conozco" (Mt 7:21-23 y Lc 13: 22-30). Hay miedo a la "fe reducida a sentimientos".

La relación se basa solo en la interpretación o conveniencia personal, en lugar de la acción objetiva y fiel de Dios en los sacramentos. Recordar, sepa que si no usa los sacramentos de gracia que recibió, pierde la gracia de Dios y su Compañerismo. Bendiciones! - Mons. Xavier

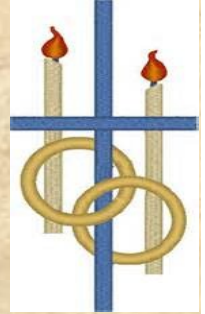
