35. Hope for Honor thru Humility

Dear brothers and sisters,

A brilliant young man, proud of his academic achievements, visited a wise monk seeking wisdom. As they talked, the monk was pouring tea into a cup until it overflowed; the young man said, can't you see it's overflowing? The monk said: "You are like this cup, already full of yourself and

pride; only if you empty yourself you can receive true wisdom." When God intends to fill a soul, He first makes it empty; when He intends to enrich a soul, He first makes it poor; when He intends to exalt a soul, He first makes it sensible of its own miseries, wants and nothingness. Humility makes space for God's grace.

In the world, honor is often measured by titles, wealth, and positions. People fight for the first place, much like the Pharisees scrambling for the best seats of honor (Lk 14) This kind of search for human applause is fragile. What people give, people can take away. It is temporary and superficial. Think of celebrities who rise and fall with public opinion. The crowd that shouts "Hosanna" quickly cry "Crucify Him." Face honor is fake honor!

Humility is not weakness, it is wisdom. It helps to listen, learn, and grow; and makes room for God's wisdom. Jesus is not teaching us about table etiquette, but about the attitudes of our lives. The humble heart is not only content with the lowest place, but also makes room for those people the society pushes aside. **Don't wait until you are humbled before you are humble.** There is a difference between being humble and being humbled – put down, or brought low. Many proud people only learn humility through humiliation. Humility is truthfulness to yourself and to others that brings honor automatically!

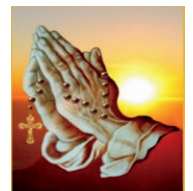

"Parents are the most important factor

in the healthy development and faith formation of their children and adolescents!"

Jim Burns has written an article entitled "How to Pass Your Faith to Your Kids." (p. 41) He offers

ten practical suggestions for parents to use as they nurture their child's spiritual development:

1. Be yourself.
2. Don't limit your conversations on spiritual matters to Sunday or weekend Mass only.
3. Let your kids see you in the act of doing something spiritual.
4. Look for natural opportunities to raise spiritual issues.
5. Take the posture of a 'fellow-learner' as opposed to that of a 'teacher and student.'
6. Utilize media to launch discussions about God and the Christian life.
7. Have a plan for family devotional and prayer times.
8. Have fun with your kids.
9. Get involved in ministry together as a family.
10. Disciple and equip your kids.

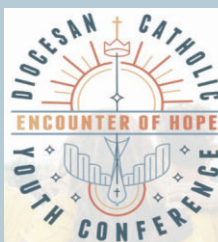

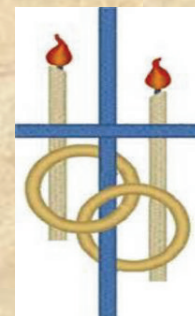
