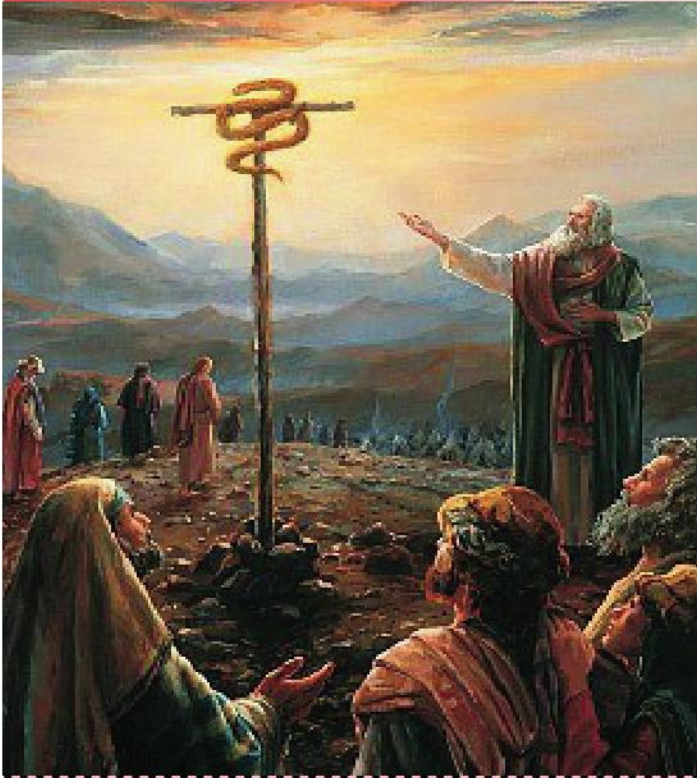

37. The Cross: Our Hope of Salvation

Dear brothers and sisters,

At first glance, the Cross is an instrument of torture and death. Yet through the lens of faith, we see a profound paradox — that through suffering came salvation, and through death came life; the glorious sign of victory, love, and hope.

Imagine a mountain climber ascending a steep path. On their back is a heavy backpack, filled not with rocks, but with essential tools: food, water, rope, first-aid supplies. At times, the weight feels unbearable. The climber is tempted to throw the pack aside and walk freely. But here's the twist; without that pack, the climber would not survive. It is the very weight that enables the journey. Thus, Christ did not avoid the Cross; He embraced it. He transformed it forever into the bridge between heaven and earth.

When the people of Israel were bitten by deadly serpents, Moses lifted up a bronze serpent in the desert (Num. 21:4-9) for the people to gaze upon the bronze serpent to be healed. This was not magic, it was a test of faith and obedience. It pointed forward to a greater healing to come.

Today, we are called to gaze on the cross as *"the hope of our salvation"*; we acknowledge that it is not merely a past event, but a present reality. It stands in the center of our Christian journey; it is our anchor, firm and secure; it reminds us that we are not abandoned; it stands as the sign that God is with us.

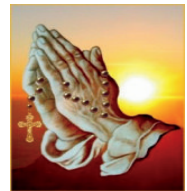
Let us, therefore, boast in the cross [Gal. 6:14]. Let us pray thus: *"We adore You, O Christ, and we bless You, because by Your holy Cross, You have redeemed the world."* Let our daily cross bring a crown of glory.

37. La Cruz: Nuestra Esperanza de Salvación

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

A primera vista, la Cruz es un instrumento de tortura y muerte. Sin embargo, a través de la fe, vemos una profunda paradoja: que a través del sufrimiento llegó la salvación, y a través de la muerte la vida; el glorioso signo de la victoria, el amor y la esperanza.

Imaginen a un alpinista ascendiendo por un sendero empinado. A sus espaldas lleva una pesada mochila, llena no de piedras, sino de herramientas esenciales: comida, agua, cuerda, botiquín. A veces, el peso se siente insoportable. El alpinista siente la tentación de tirar la mochila a un lado y caminar libremente. Pero aquí está el giro: sin esa mochila, el alpinista no sobreviviría. Es precisamente ese peso lo que permite el viaje.

Así, Cristo no evitó la Cruz; la abrazó. La transformó para siempre en el puente entre el cielo y la tierra. Cuando el pueblo de Israel fue mordido por serpientes mortales, Moisés levantó una serpiente de bronce en el desierto (Núm. 21:4-9) para que el pueblo la contemplara y sanara. Esto no fue magia, sino una prueba de fe y obediencia. Adelantó una sanación mayor por venir.

Hoy estamos llamados a contemplar la cruz como "la esperanza de nuestra salvación"; reconocemos que no es solo un acontecimiento pasado, sino una realidad presente. Por lo tanto, gloriémonos en la cruz [Gal. 6:14]. Oremos así: "Te adoramos, oh Cristo, y te bendecimos, porque por tu santa cruz redimiste al mundo". Que nuestra cruz diaria nos traiga una corona de gloria.
