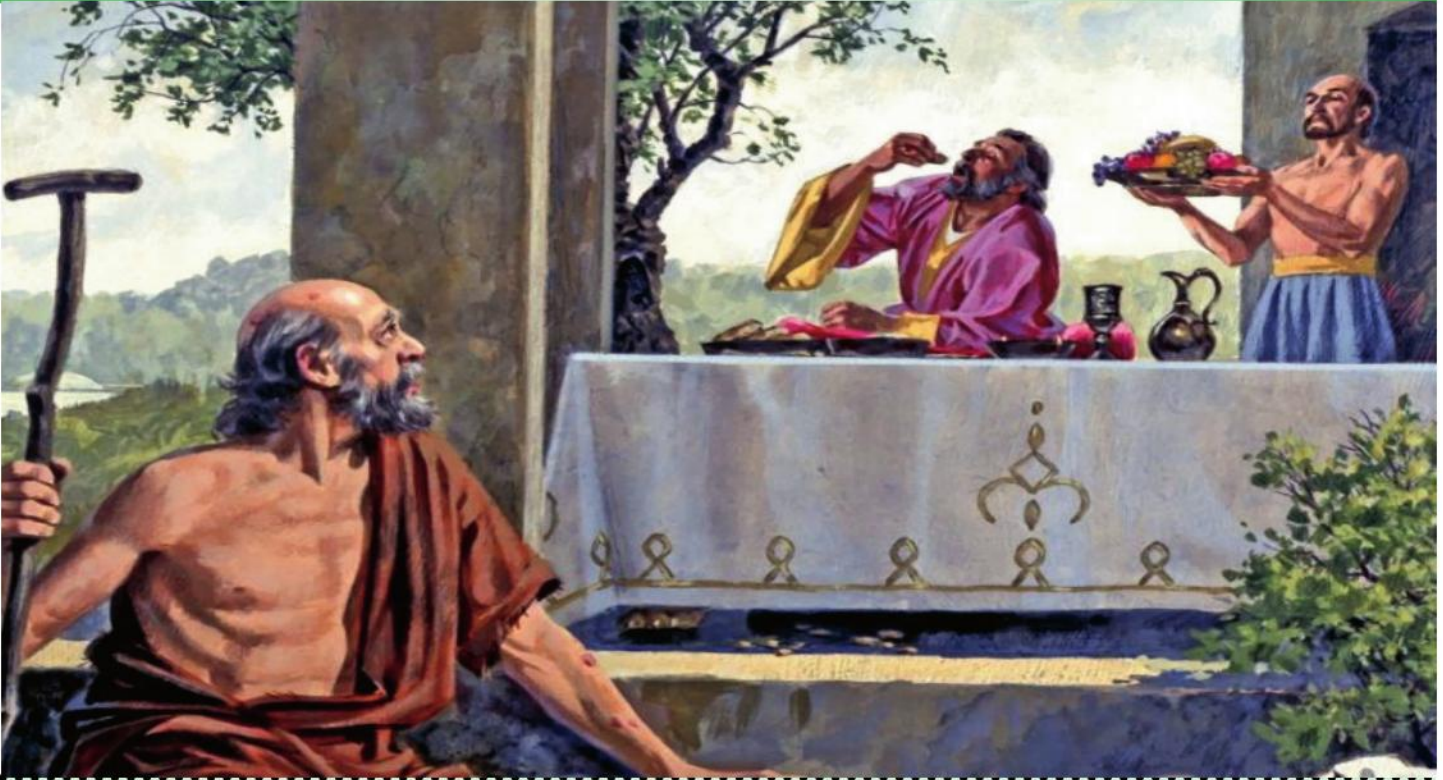

40. Hope for Rich and Poor

My brothers and sisters,
 In the world there is a tension that divides rich and poor, power and weakness, greed and generosity. Yet in this tension, God offers a hope that He wants all to be saved.

A wealthy merchant and a poor farmer were neighbors. The merchant, though rich, could not sleep at night because of constant worries, while the poor farmer, though having little, slept peacefully after praying with his family. When asked how he found such peace, the farmer said he trusted God and shared what little he had. The merchant learned to use his wealth for others, and in giving, he finally found peace.

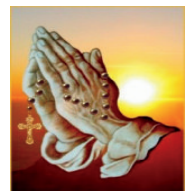
Prophet Amos denounces the 'Complacency of the Comfortable', the wealthy, while they are blind to the ruin of the poor. Comfort becomes dangerous when it closes our eyes to the poor. Jesus deepens Amos' warning with the story of the rich man clothed in purple and fine linen, who feasts daily, while at his gate lies Lazarus, covered with sores. The rich man is not condemned because he was rich, but because he was blind to Lazarus. He ignored him. Even in the afterlife, his arrogance lingers—he still wants Lazarus to serve him. The chasm that separates them in eternity was dug in life by the choices of the rich man, who refused to cross the small chasm of compassion while he lived. Wealth without love creates walls; compassion tears them down.

St. Paul exhorts us to flee from greed. Wealth is fleeting; virtue endures. True greatness is not found in luxury, but in fighting "the good fight of faith" and extending our compassionate hands to others in love, patience and gentleness. Wealth without love creates walls; compassion tears them down the division. Let us be rich in God. Prayers and Blessings! Msgr. Xavier

October: Month of the Holy Rosary

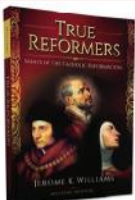

Praying Rosary- Practical Benefits for Children

Develops Patience and Focus:

The repetitive nature of the prayers and the physical act of moving beads through their fingers helps children slow down, concentrate, and maintain focus.

Calm and Centering:

The rhythmic repetition of prayers can be soothing, helping children develop inner stillness.

Keeps Hands Occupied:

Holding and moving the rosary beads keeps children's hands busy while they are meditating on the mysteries.

Provides a "Spiritual Weapon": The rosary is seen as a powerful tool to combat sin and evil, offering a form of spiritual defense.



Who is a Guardian Angel?

A Guardian angel is an angel (a created, non-human, non-corporeal being) that has been assigned to guard a particular person, especially with respect to helping that person avoid spiritual dangers and achieve salvation. The angel may also help the person avoid physical dangers, particularly if this will help the person achieve salvation.

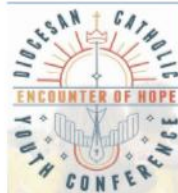

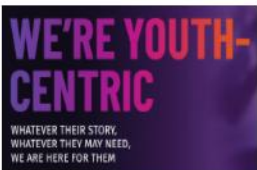

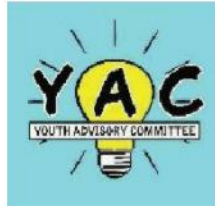

40. Esperanza para Ricos y Pobres

Hermanos y hermanas,

En nuestro mundo existe tensión entre ricos y pobres, poder y debilidad, avaricia y generosidad. Sin embargo, Dios ofrece una esperanza que une a ambos: la esperanza de volver a Él.

Un comerciante rico y un granjero pobre eran vecinos. El comerciante, aunque rico, no podía dormir por las preocupaciones, mientras que el granjero, aunque pobre, dormía tranquilo después de orar con su familia. Cuando se le preguntó, el granjero dijo que confiaba en Dios y compartía lo poco que tenía. El comerciante aprendió a usar su riqueza para los demás, y al dar, encontró paz.

El profeta Amós denuncia la «complacencia de los cómodos», los ricos, mientras que estos se ciegan ante la ruina de los pobres. La comodidad se vuelve peligrosa cuando nos cierra los ojos ante... Jesús profundiza la advertencia de Amós con la historia del hombre rico y Lázaro. Incluso en el más allá, su arrogancia persiste; todavía quiere que Lázaro lo sirva. El abismo que los separa en la eternidad fue cavado en vida por las decisiones del hombre rico, quien se negó a cruzar el pequeño abismo de la compasión mientras vivió. La riqueza sin amor crea muros; la compasión los derriba.

San Pablo nos exhorta a huir de la avaricia. La riqueza es fugaz; la virtud perdura. La verdadera grandeza no se encuentra en el lujo, sino en luchar «la buena batalla de la fe» y aferrarse firmemente a la vida eterna. La riqueza sin amor crea muros; la compasión los derriba. Seamos ricos en Dios. Bendiciones y oraciones.

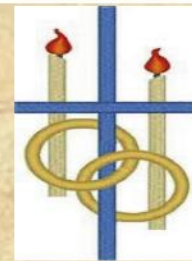

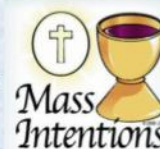

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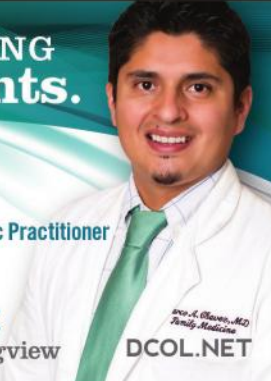
