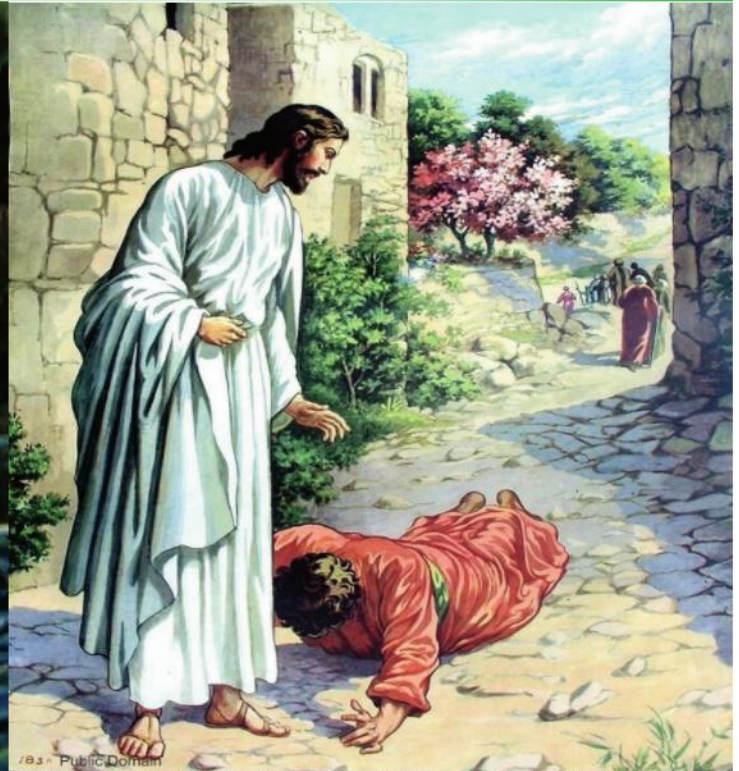
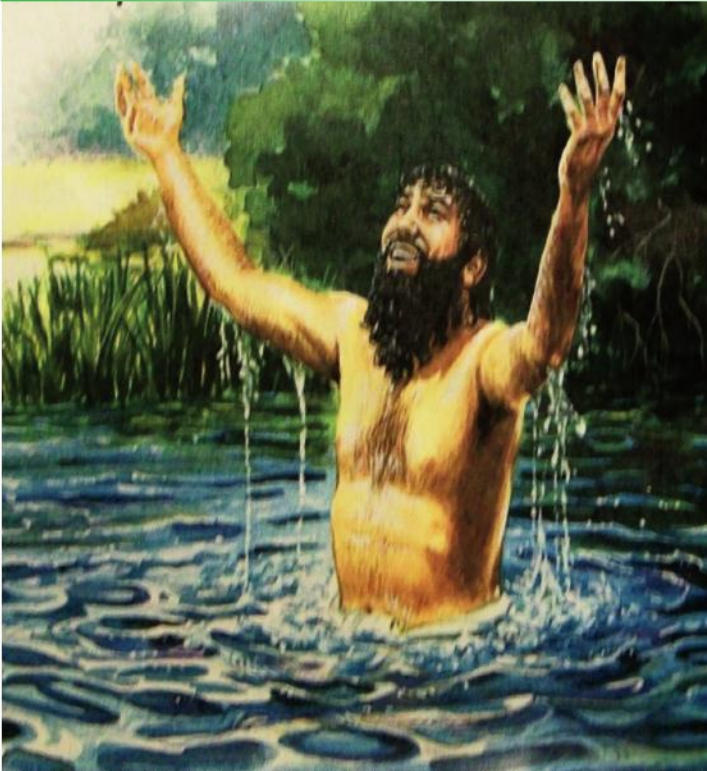

42. Hope + Faith = Gratitude

Dear brothers and sisters,
Our faith is a gift from God – if rooted in God and His Words the grace of God nurtures (last week). This is revealed in the healings of Naaman the pagan commander, and the Samaritan. Their healing was rooted in obedience to God's Word. These healings reveal three movements of faith and invite us to reflect on our faith.

Humility: Naaman expected a dramatic miracle, but instead, the prophet Elisha instructed him to bathe in the simple waters of the Jordan. Only when Naaman humbled himself did healing come. The ten lepers, outcast of their community, cried out to Jesus from a distance; unworthy to come closer to Him.

Obedience: The cleansing wasn't in the water itself but in obedience to God's command. Naaman's pride nearly blocked his healing, but his surrender opened the way to grace. Jesus commanded the lepers to go and show themselves to the priest. No questions or doubts; all obeyed Jesus' Words. On the way they were healed.

Gratitude: After healing, Naaman glorified God, confessed his faith in the living God. His reward was not just a physical restoration but also conversion of heart. The leper Samaritan returned instantly to glorify God and showed himself to Jesus, the priest.

Physical restoration is temporary; spiritual healing lasts forever. When we glorify God in gratitude, He rewards us with more than we asked for—peace, deeper faith, and salvation.

May our lives glorify God, not only in the moments of healing, but in everything we do.

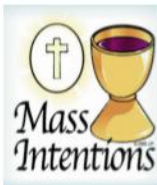

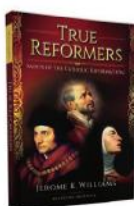

Calming and Centering:

The rhythmic repetition of prayers can be soothing, helping children develop inner stillness.

Keeps Hands Occupied:

Holding and moving the rosary beads keeps children's hands busy while they are meditating on the mysteries.

Provides a "Spiritual Weapon": The rosary is seen as a powerful tool to combat sin and evil, offering a form of spiritual defense.

42. Esperanza + Fe = Gratitude

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

La fe es un don de Dios que, arraigada en su Palabra, La fe conduce a la gratitud Queridos hermanos y hermanas, Nuestra fe es un don de Dios; si está arraigada en Dios y en su Palabra, la gracia de Dios la nutre (la semana pasada). Esto se revela en las sanaciones de Naamán, el comandante pagano y del samaritano. Su sanación se basó en la obediencia a la Palabra de Dios. Estas sanaciones revelan tres movimientos de fe e invitan a reflexionar sobre nuestra fe.

Humildad: Naamán esperaba un milagro extraordinario, pero solo al obedecer la indicación sencilla de bañarse en el Jordán alcanzó la sanación. Los diez leprosos, excluidos, clamaron a Jesús desde lejos.

Obediencia: No es el agua la que purifica, sino la obediencia al mandato de Dios. Naamán venció su orgullo y se abrió a la gracia. Los leprosos obedecieron a Jesús y, en el camino, fueron sanados.

Gratitud: Tras sanar, Naamán glorificó a Dios y confesó su fe en el Dios vivo. Su recompensa no fue solo la restauración física, sino también la conversión de su corazón. El leproso samaritano volvió al instante a glorificar a Dios y se presentó ante Jesús, el sacerdote. La restauración física es temporal; la sanidad espiritual dura para siempre.

Cuando glorificamos a Dios con gratitud, Él siempre nos recompensa con más de lo que pedimos: paz, una fe más profunda y salvación. Que nuestras vidas glorifiquen a Dios, no solo en los momentos de sanación, sino en cada respiro que tomamos.

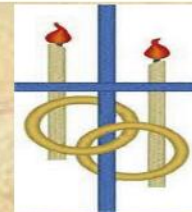
