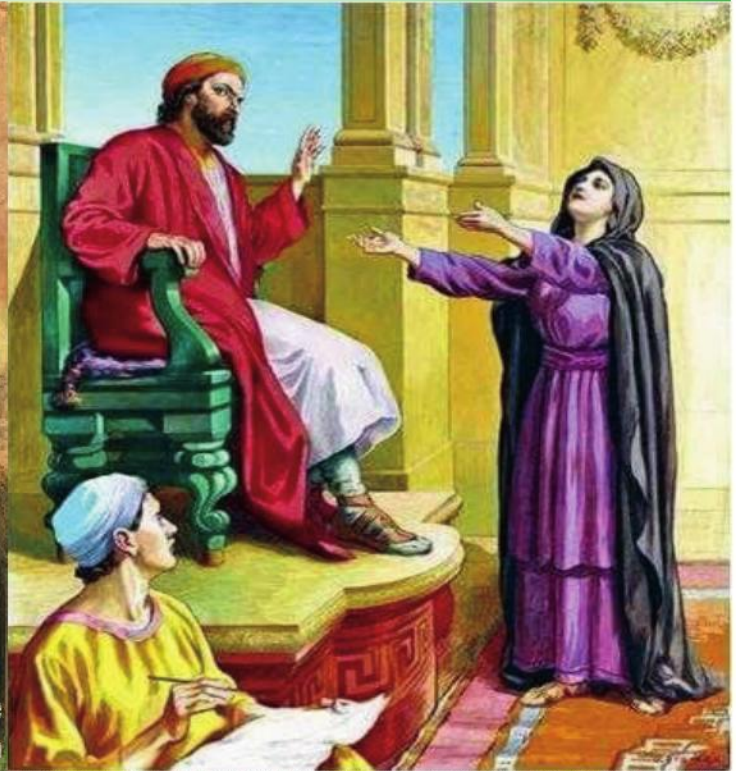

**43. Praying Family Vs Family Prayer**

Dear brothers and sisters,  
A family had prayed the rosary every evening for years for their son who had drifted away, they never stopped, even when nothing changed. After twenty years, that son returned home and said, “I could never forget the sound of your praying for me. It was the sound of hope.” God may seem silent, but no persistent family prayer goes unheard.

When Moses raised his hands in prayer during the battle against Amalek, Israel prevailed. When his hands grew weary, Aaron and Hur came to support him. Together, they won the victory—not because of military strength, but because of *unity in prayer*. This image is a beautiful picture of what a praying family is called to be. Every home has its battles—financial worries, sickness, misunderstandings, or spiritual fatigue. When a member grows weary, others must hold them up in prayer. The same with the widows’ persistent plea that gave her a just judgement for her family.

A family that prays together does not mean that problems disappear, but that they stand together under God’s strength. In that moment, their prayer becomes the unseen power that keeps the family victorious by the quiet endurance of hope.

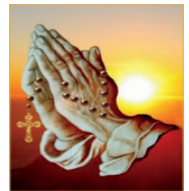
A mother once said, “When my husband lost his job, I gathered my children every night to pray. Months later, he found work again—but more importantly, we found unity. “Before, we were just a family,” she said. “Now, we are a family that believes together.” That’s the power of family prayer: it changes the *heart* of the home.

#### Calming and Centering:

The rhythmic repetition of prayers can be soothing, helping children develop inner stillness.

Holding and moving the rosary beads keeps children's hands busy while they are meditating on the mysteries.

Provides a "Spiritual Weapon": The rosary is seen as a powerful tool to combat sin and evil, offering a form of spiritual defense.

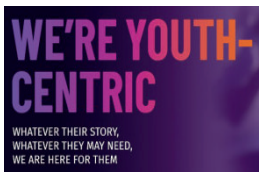

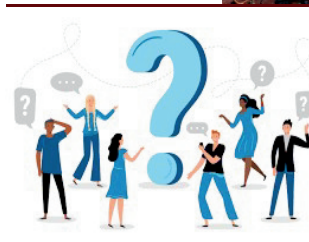

### 43. Oración Familiar Vs. Familiar Oración

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

Hay una historia famosa de una familia que rezó el rosario todas las noches durante años por su hijo que se había alejado. Nunca se detuvieron, incluso cuando nada cambiaba. Después de veinte años, ese hijo regresó a casa y dijo: «Nunca olvidaré el sonido de sus voces orando por mí. Era el sonido de la esperanza». Dios puede parecer silencioso, pero ninguna oración familiar pasa desapercibida.

Cuando Moisés alzó las manos en oración durante la batalla contra Amalec, Israel prevaleció. Cuando sus manos se cansaron, Aarón y Hur acudieron a apoyarlo. Juntos, obtuvieron la victoria, no por su fuerza militar, sino por la unidad en la oración. Esta imagen es una hermosa representación de lo que una familia que ora está llamada a ser. Cada hogar tiene sus batallas: preocupaciones financieras, enfermedades, fatiga espiritual. Cuando un miembro se cansa, los demás deben alzar las manos en oración.

En ese momento, la oración se convierte en el poder invisible que mantiene a la familia victoriosa, no con fuerza, sino con la silenciosa perseverancia de la esperanza.

Una madre dijo una vez: “Cuando mi esposo perdió su trabajo, reunía a mis hijos todas las noches para orar. Meses después, volvió a trabajar, pero lo más importante es que encontramos unidad. “Antes, éramos solo una familia”, dijo. “Ahora, somos una familia que cree unida”. Ese es el poder de la oración familiar: transforma el corazón del hogar.

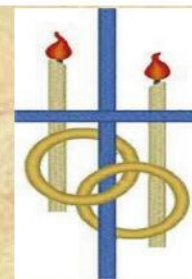
