44. Be Humble or Stumble!

Dear brothers and sisters,

Two ducks and a frog lived happily in a pond until it began to dry up. The ducks could fly to another pond, but the frog couldn't. They devised a plan: the ducks held a stick in their bills while the frog clung to it with his mouth. As they flew, a farmer admired their cleverness and wondered who thought of it. The proud frog replied, "I did," and opened his mouth, ending the plan. "Be humble or you'll stumble." Right!

God listens to the humble of heart. [Luke 18:9-14]. The Pharisee stands tall and boasts of his good deeds, while the tax collector, standing at a distance, beats his breast and prays simply, "O God, be merciful to me, a sinner." Jesus declares that it was the tax collector who went home justified. Pharisee lost his grace by his pride.

The truth is that humility opens the door to God's mercy. Pride builds a wall between us and God and others, while humility tears it down. The humble person recognizes his dependence on God, his need for forgiveness, and his trust in God's goodness rather than his own merit.

To be humble in prayer is to see ourselves truthfully — loved by God yet in need of His grace. In our world today, where achievement and recognition are often glorified, humility can seem like weakness. Yet it is the very strength that draws God's attention. The prayer of the humble pierces the clouds (Sirach 35:17); it may not be answered in the way we expect, but it always reaches the heart of God. They that know God will be humble, and they that know themselves cannot be proud.

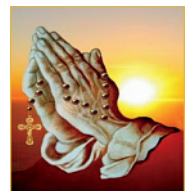

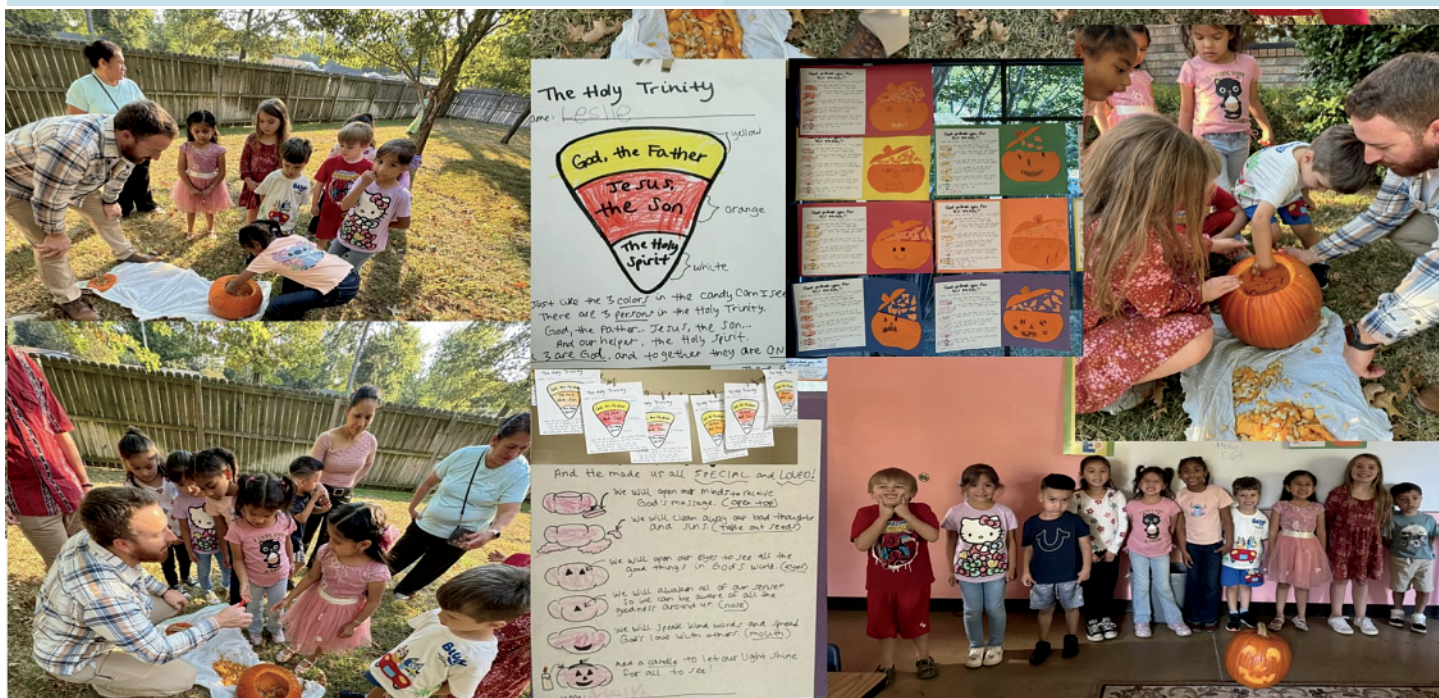

44. ¡Sé humilde o tropezarás!

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

Dos patos y una rana vivían felices en un estanque hasta que este empezó a secarse. Los patos podían volar a otro estanque, pero la rana no. Idearon un plan: los patos sostenían un palo en el pico mientras la rana se aferraba a él con la boca. Mientras volaban, un granjero admiró su astucia y se preguntó a quién se le habría ocurrido. La rana orgullosa respondió: "Yo", y abrió la boca, dando por terminado el plan. "Sé humilde o tropezarás". ¡Correcto!

Dios escucha a los humildes de corazón. [Lucas 18:9-14].

El fariseo se yergue y se jacta de sus buenas obras, mientras que el recaudador de impuestos, de pie a cierta distancia, se golpea el pecho y ora con sencillez: "Oh, Dios, ten piedad de mí, pecador". Jesús declara que fue el recaudador de impuestos quien regresó a casa justificado. El fariseo perdió su gracia por su orgullo.

La verdad es que la humildad abre la puerta a la misericordia de Dios. El orgullo construye un muro entre nosotros, Dios y los demás, mientras que la humildad lo derriba. La persona humilde reconoce su dependencia de Dios, su necesidad de perdón y su confianza en la bondad de Dios, más que en sus propios méritos.

Ser humilde en la oración es vernos con sinceridad: amados por Dios, pero necesitados de su gracia. En nuestro mundo actual, donde a menudo se glorifican los logros y el reconocimiento, la humildad puede parecer una debilidad. Sin embargo, es precisamente la fuerza la que atrae la atención de Dios. La oración del humilde atraviesa las nubes (Eclesiástico 35:17); puede que no sea respondida como esperamos, pero siempre llega al corazón de Dios. Quienes conocen a Dios serán humildes, y quienes se conocen a sí mismos no pueden ser orgullosos.

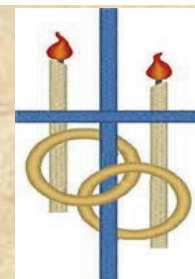
