45. Pilgrims of Hope

Dear brothers and sisters,

On this **All Souls' Day**, the Church gathers as one family, the living and the dead, united in Christ's love that conquers death. Today, we remember those who have gone before us; we pray in hope for their purification and eternal peace.

This day awakens the ache of loss, the empty chair, the familiar voice now silent, the memory that stirs both tears and gratitude. Yet in the light of faith, we see beyond the grave. Death is not the end; it is a passage. The souls we entrust to God are not lost to us - they live in Him, and through our prayers, our love reaches them still.

A child once watched her grandmother weaving a tapestry. From underneath, it looked tangled — full of knots and threads going nowhere. But when the grandmother turned it around, the child saw a beautiful picture. From our side of life, death may look like a tangle of loss and separation. But on the other side, God's side, all threads are woven together into beauty. The living and the departed are part of the same masterpiece of love. *"Nothing can separate us from the love of God."* [Rom. 8:38-39]

So today, as we light candles and whisper the names of those we love, let us remember: **we are pilgrims of hope.** The light we hold is not only for the souls who sleep in Christ, but also for ourselves — to guide us in faith until the day when every tear is wiped away and all are made new in the Resurrection. In every Eucharist, heaven and earth meet; the living and the dead meet; and we are being gathered into the heart of God.

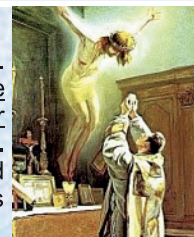

Friends, therefore witnesses

Christian witness arises from friendship with the Lord, who was crucified and rose for the salvation of all. This witness is not to be confused with ideological propaganda, for it is an authentic principle of interior transformation and social awareness. Jesus chose to call his disciples "friends." He made known to them the Kingdom of God, asked them to remain with him, to become his community, and sent them to proclaim the Gospel (cf. Jn 15:15, 27). So when Jesus tells us, "Be witnesses," he is assuring us that he considers us as his friends. He alone fully knows who we are and why we are here; young people, he knows your heart, your indignation in the face of discrimination and injustice, your desire for truth and beauty, for joy and peace. Through his friendship, he listens to you, motivates you, and guides you, calling each of you to a new life.

45. Peregrinos de la Esperanza

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

En este Día de los Fieles Difuntos, la Iglesia se reúne como una sola familia, vivos y muertos, unidos en el amor de Cristo que vence a la muerte. Hoy recordamos a quienes nos precedieron; oramos con esperanza por su purificación y paz eterna.

Para muchos, este día despierta el dolor de la pérdida: la silla vacía, la voz familiar ahora silenciada, el recuerdo que despierta lágrimas y gratitud. Sin embargo, a la luz de la fe, vemos más allá de la tumba. La muerte no es el final; es un paso. Las almas que confiamos a Dios no están perdidas para nosotros; viven en Él, y a través de nuestras oraciones, nuestro amor aún las alcanza.

Una vez, una niña observó a su abuela tejer un tapiz. Desde abajo, parecía enredado, lleno de nudos e hilos que no llevaban a ninguna parte. Pero cuando la abuela le dio la vuelta, la niña vio una hermosa imagen. Desde nuestra perspectiva, la muerte puede parecer una maraña de pérdida y separación. Pero en el otro lado, el lado de Dios, todos los hilos se entrelazan en belleza. Los vivos y los difuntos forman parte de la misma obra maestra de amor. «Nada nos puede separar del amor de Dios» [Rom. 8:38-39].

Así que hoy, al encender velas y susurrar los nombres de nuestros seres queridos, recordemos: somos un pueblo peregrino de esperanza. La luz que sostenemos no es solo para las almas que duermen en Cristo, sino también para nosotros mismos, para guiarnos en la fe hasta el día en que toda lágrima sea enjugada y todos seamos renovados en la Resurrección. En cada Eucaristía, el cielo y la tierra se encuentran; los vivos y los muertos se encuentran; y somos reunidos en el corazón de Dios.

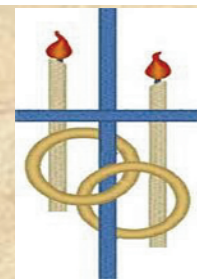
