46. Living Stones VS Stony Living

Dear brothers and sisters,

The Lateran Basilica, being the Pope's Cathedral as Bishop of Rome, symbolizes the unity of the whole Church gathered around the successor of Peter. It is called the "Mother and Head of all Churches in the world." Its importance supersedes our normal Sunday liturgy. This feast is a reminder that we ourselves are the living temples of God.

Jesus called His body, "The Temple." [Jn. 2] This image reminds us that wherever God dwells, there is life, healing, and fruitfulness. [Ez. 47] When we allow His Spirit to dwell within us, our hearts too become streams of grace - bringing forgiveness, kindness, and renewal to the world around us. Therefore, St. Paul tells: "Do you not know that you are God's temple, and that God's Spirit dwells in you?" (1 Cor 3:16)

This truth is both consoling and challenging. Consoling, because God chooses to dwell not in distant heavens, but within our very lives. Challenging, because we must make sure that our inner temple is kept holy - free from pride, bitterness, and sin. Through baptism, confirmation, and the Eucharist, we have been consecrated - set apart to be God's dwelling place. Our hearts are the sanctuary of the Holy Spirit. We are dedicated that the grace of God would flow from us to give life to people.

God's presence no longer dwells in stone walls but in a living person. Our homes, families, and communities become sacred when we forgive, serve, pray, and love generously, we are re-dedicating ourselves as living temples of the Lord. The living stones builds the living temple. When we refuse to give life, we live a stony life. Let us live and give life. Blessings! -Msgr. Xavier

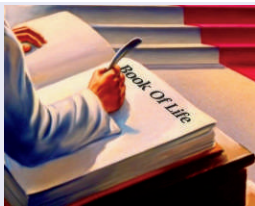

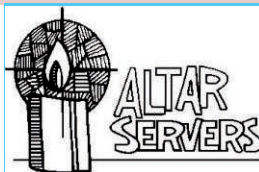

Pope Leo's message: 40th WORLD YOUTH DAY:

Friends, therefore witnesses

Let us consider the message the Apostle John gives us at the end of the fourth Gospel: "This is the disciple who is bearing witness to these things, and who has written these things; and we know that his testimony is true" (Jn 21:24). The entire preceding account is summarized as a "testimony," full of gratitude and wonder, from a disciple who never reveals his name, but calls himself "the disciple whom Jesus loved." This title reflects a relationship: it is not the name of an individual, but the testimony of a personal bond with Christ. That is what really matters to John: being a disciple of the Lord and feeling loved by him. We understand, then, that Christian witness is the fruit of a relationship of faith and love with Jesus, in whom we find the salvation of our lives. What the Apostle John writes also refers to you, dear young people. You are invited by Christ to follow him and sit beside him, to listen to his heart and share closely in his life! Each one of you is a "beloved disciple" for him, and from this love comes the joy of witness.

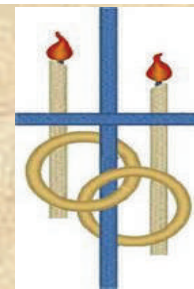
