“From the Tomb to the Table”

Dear brothers and sisters,
Jesus called us to step out of our “tombs.” The tomb begins wherever we refuse to let Christ truly reign; it holds all that weighs us down: sin, fear, and spiritual fatigue. When Christ steps out of the tomb, He opens a path for us to leave behind whatever keeps us spiritually buried. Before we move from the tomb to the table, we must confront our past “tombs”

On Holy Thursday, Jesus invites the disciples to the table to nourish /strengthen them for the journey and to teach them to love and serve one another. To receive this gift, we must allow ourselves to be humbled, served, and transformed.

On Good Friday, we encounter the Cross: silence replaces words, loss replaces certainty, and the tomb becomes real. This passage is unavoidable. Every “tomb experience” becomes the place where transformation begins. We must die to ourselves in order to truly live.

At Easter, the stone is rolled away. Christ rises and seeks His disciples, leading them to recognize Him at a ‘table fellowship’ - to a living relationship. Now, the tomb is empty; the table is full; Christ is with us always.

Saint Francis lived this journey: his conversion, poverty, and love for the priesthood and Eucharist reveal the movement from death to his self into communion with Christ.

Let us keep moving from our tombs to the table of the Lord—not as spectators, but as participants. In the Eucharist, we meet the Risen Lord, who sends us forth to help others to step out of their tombs and come to His table. **Happy Easter! Peace & Blessings! -Msgr. Xavier**

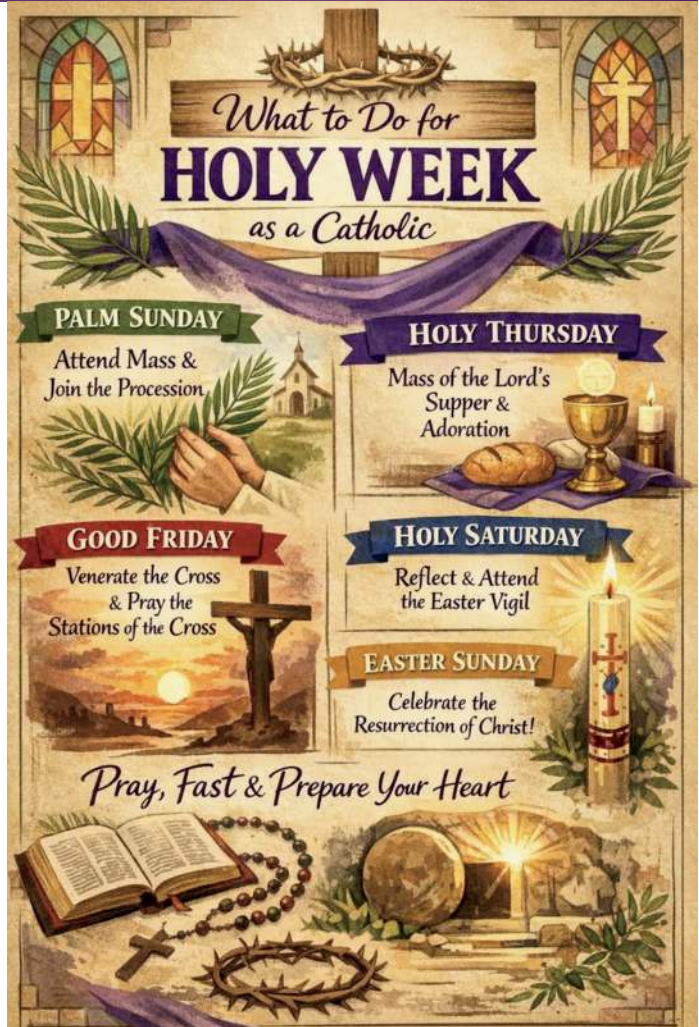

De la Tumba a la Mesa

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

Jesús llamó a Lázaro a salir de su tumba; nosotros también hemos salido de las nuestras. La tumba comienza donde no dejamos que Cristo reine: allí se encierran el pecado, el miedo, el arrepentimiento y la fatiga espiritual. Cuando Cristo sale de la tumba, nos abre un camino para dejar atrás lo que nos mantiene sepultados. Antes de pasar de la tumba a la mesa, debemos confrontar nuestro pasado y entregarnos al futuro.

El Jueves Santo, Jesús reúne a sus discípulos y les entrega la Eucaristía —la mesa— para nutrirlos y enseñarles a amarse y servirse. Aquí Cristo se entrega por completo. Para recibir este don, debemos dejarnos humillar, servir y transformar.

El Viernes Santo, encontramos el peso de la Cruz: el silencio sustituye a las palabras y la tumba se vuelve real. Este paso es inevitable. Toda experiencia de tumba se convierte en el lugar donde comienza la transformación. Debemos morir a nosotros mismos para vivir verdaderamente.

En la Pascua, la piedra es removida. Cristo resucita y conduce a sus discípulos a reconocerlo en la fracción del pan, hacia la comunión viva. La Resurrección nos lleva de nuevo a la mesa, ahora transformada. La tumba está vacía; la mesa está colmada.

San Francisco vivió este camino: su conversión y amor a la Eucaristía revelan el paso de la muerte a sí mismo hacia la comunión con Cristo. Sigamos avanzando de la tumba a la mesa del Señor, como participantes. En la Eucaristía encontramos al Resucitado, que nos envía a ayudar a otros. ¡Felices Pascuas!

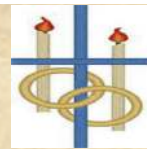
