Resurrection Be Visible Daily



Dear brothers and sisters,
Christ is risen - *Alleluia!* In this radiant light of the Resurrection, we are invited to see ourselves, others and the world anew.

Our garden and trees in winter look dead - dry soil, bare branches, no color. But beneath the surface, life is quietly waiting.

When spring comes, everything begins to bloom again. God brings life where we only see endings. When we feel spiritually dry or distant from God, Easter reminds us that new life is already beginning within us.

Easter is not only the celebration of Christ’s victory over death; it is the revelation of *true life*. In a world often marked by fear, division, and woundedness, Easter calls us to become instruments of peace. The empty tomb is a mission. It tells us that love is stronger than hatred, mercy stronger than judgment, and light stronger than darkness.

A young professional, tired after a long day, waited at a bus stop and noticed a homeless man everyone else was avoiding. Feeling uncomfortable but choosing not to ignore him, he approached and asked his name - Michael. They shared a brief conversation, and the young man later bought him a sandwich. As the bus arrived, Michael softly thanked him—not just for the food, but for truly seeing and paying attention to him.



Easter is not only something we celebrate, it is something we live. Every act of forgiveness, every choice for peace, is a sign that Christ is risen. Let us make that resurrection visible in our world. Let us go forth, then, as Easter people proclaiming with our lives what we profess with our lips: **Christ is risen. He is truly risen. 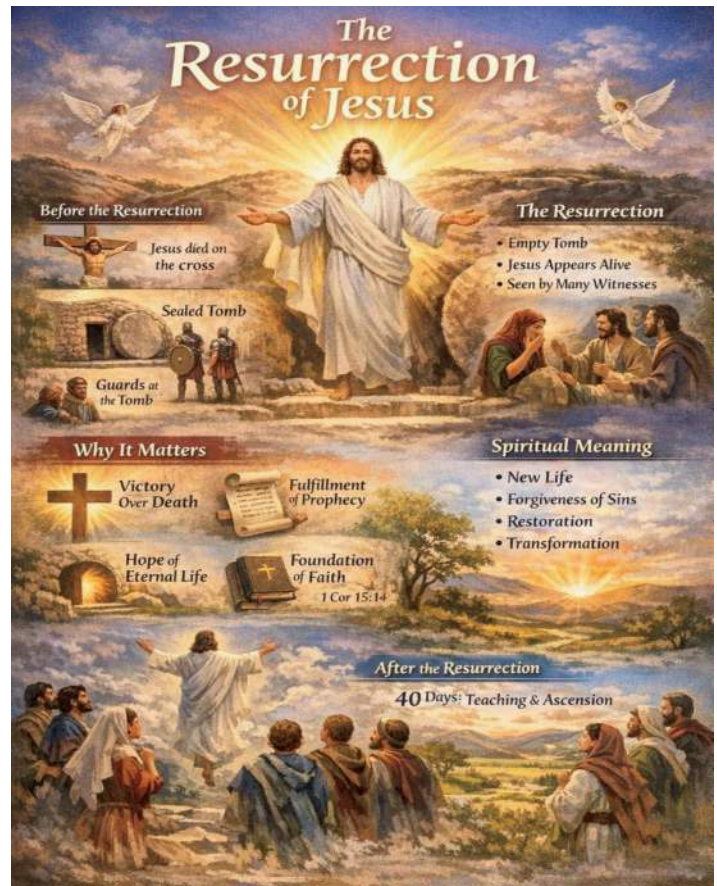

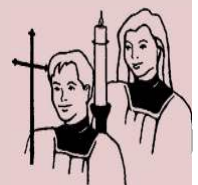

La Resurrección Visible Cada Día

Queridos hermanos y hermanas:

¡Cristo ha resucitado! ¡Aleluya! En la luz de la Resurrección, somos invitados a vernos a nosotros mismos, a los demás y al mundo con una mirada renovada.

Nuestro jardín, en invierno, parece muerto: tierra seca y ramas desnudas. Pero bajo la superficie, la vida espera en silencio. Cuando llega la primavera, todo florece de nuevo. Así también, cuando nos sentimos espiritualmente secos o lejos de Dios, la Pascua nos recuerda que una vida nueva ya está comenzando en nuestro interior.

La Pascua no es solo la victoria de Cristo sobre la muerte, sino la certeza de que la verdadera vida prevalece. En un mundo marcado por el miedo y la división, nos llama a ser instrumentos de paz. El sepulcro vacío es una misión: nos recuerda que el amor es más fuerte que el odio, la misericordia más fuerte que el juicio y la luz más fuerte que la oscuridad.

Un joven profesional, cansado tras una larga jornada, esperaba en una parada de autobús y reparó en un hombre sin hogar a quien todos los demás evitaban. Aunque se sentía incómodo, decidió no ignorarlo; se acercó y le preguntó su nombre: Michael. Compartieron una breve conversación y, más tarde, el joven le compró un sándwich. Al llegar el autobús, Michael le dio las gracias en voz baja; no solo por la comida, sino por haberlo visto verdaderamente.

La Pascua no es solo algo que celebramos; es algo que vivimos. Cada acto de perdón, cada elección a favor de la paz, es un signo de que Cristo ha resucitado. Hagamos visible esa resurrección en nuestro mundo. Avancemos, pues, como pueblo de Pascua, proclamando con nuestras vidas aquello que profesamos con nuestros labios: ¡Cristo ha resucitado! ¡Verdaderamente ha resucitado! ¡Aleluya! ¡Paz y bendiciones! — Mons. 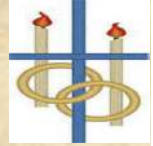
