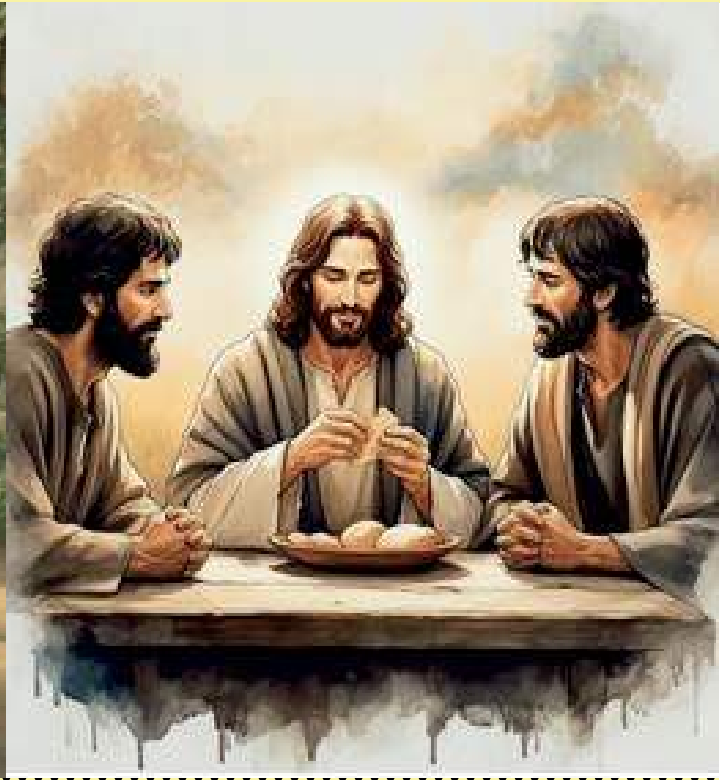

Broken Hearts to Burning Hearts

Dear brothers and sisters,
In our lives, our journey brings lots of stress, troubles, pain and heart-breaking moments, but to a believer in God it turns out to be a blessing, joyful moments of a burning heart.

Broken heart: “We were hoping...”. The two disciples walking away from Jerusalem are the picture of spiritual exhaustion. They are walking away from the community of believers, retreating into the sunset - a symbol of fading hope. Their words, “We were hoping that he would be the one to set Israel free,” are heart-broken words. Even when Jesus joins them, they cannot see Him. Their grief has created a veil.

Turning Point: “The breaking of the Word & the Bread”. Jesus doesn’t immediately reveal His face; He begins by revealing the Word through the lens of the prophets. He shows them that what they thought was a “failure” (the Cross) was actually the “fulfillment” of God’s plan; their internal temperature changes. They later remark, “... our hearts burning within us.” This reminds us that even when we feel “heartbroken”, when we hear the Word, it is quietly at work, rekindling our hope from the inside out.

Burning Heart: The climax of the journey occurs not on the road, but at the table - they recognize Him at breaking of the Bread (Eucharist). And He vanishes. Why? Because He is no longer just a traveler *beside* them; He is now a presence within them through the Bread of Life.

Their broken hearts are thoroughly replaced by burning hearts that they immediately turn around, same night, run seven miles back to Jerusalem to share the news. True joy cannot be kept to oneself; it demands a “return” to the family and community. Jesus doesn’t wait for us to find our way back to Him. He comes to find us on the road of our daily life and stays with us.

Dress Code: First Holy Communion & Confirmation

Girls: Dresses are NOT to be shorter than the knee or longer than the ankle. NO FORMALS. For those receiving First Holy Communion, the dress code is white; for the Confirmands, any color is permitted. Dress shoes or dress sandals (no tennis shoes). No dresses with spaghetti straps or without sleeves will be permitted. Without proper dress you may not be permitted to participate in the sacraments.

Boys: 1st Holy Communion: Dress shirt must be white, long or short sleeve. Dress pants may be white, navy blue or black. Ties - white, navy blue or black;

Boys: Confirmation: Dress shirt of any solid color. Dark dress pants - navy blue or black; (no tennis shoes); Suit coats or jackets are optional (not a requirement).

De corazones rotos a corazones ardientes

Queridos hermanos y hermanas:

En nuestras vidas, el caminar nos trae estrés, problemas, dolor y momentos desgarradores; sin embargo, para quien cree en Dios, todo puede transformarse en bendición, en el gozo de un corazón ardiente.

Corazón roto: «Nosotros esperábamos...». Los dos discípulos que se alejan de Jerusalén reflejan el agotamiento espiritual. Se apartan de la comunidad, como una esperanza que se apaga. Sus palabras — «Nosotros esperábamos que él liberaría a Israel» — brotan de un corazón herido. Incluso cuando Jesús se acerca, no logran reconocerlo: el dolor les ha nublado la vista.

Punto de inflexión: «La Palabra y el Pan». Jesús no se revela de inmediato; primero les abre las Escrituras y les muestra que lo que parecía fracaso (la Cruz) era cumplimiento del plan de Dios. Entonces su interior comienza a cambiar. Más tarde dirán: «¿No ardía nuestro corazón?». Aun con el corazón roto, la Palabra actúa silenciosamente y reaviva la esperanza.

Corazón ardiente: El momento decisivo no ocurre en el camino, sino en la mesa: lo reconocen al partir el Pan (la Eucaristía). Él desaparece porque ya no es solo un compañero externo, sino presencia viva dentro de ellos.

Sus corazones rotos se transforman en ardientes, y de inmediato regresan a Jerusalén para compartir la alegría. La verdadera alegría no se guarda: nos impulsa a volver a la comunidad. Jesús no espera que lo encontremos; Él sale a nuestro encuentro y permanece con nosotros.

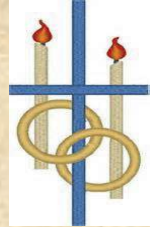

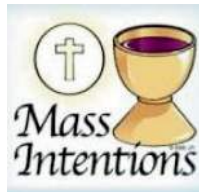
