Called to Serve Undisturbed

Dear brothers and sisters,
 Life is often defined by transition - moving houses, changing jobs, losing loved ones, or shifting stages of life. The disciples were facing the biggest transition of their lives the departure of Jesus. He tells them, “I am going away...let not your hearts be troubled.” He offered them a roadmap of the future, “I am the way, the truth and the life.” assuring their destination.

He breathed on them and made them the “living stones” to build His dynamic Church; through their individual holiness and actions contributing to the stability and beauty of the entire church/community. He doesn’t want us not to be disturbed when we face troubles. “In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world.” (John 16:33)

The early Church faced a very practical problem in their daily living causing tension between groups. They solved it through structural change and shared leadership. They empowered seven deacons to handle the practical needs of the people; and served God – a synodal church. Holiness isn’t just about what happens in our hearts; it’s about how we organize our lives to care for others and include everyone to follow “the Way”.

William Booth, the founder of the Salvation Army had lost his eyesight in his later years. He said, “I have done what I could for God and for His people with my eyes. Now I shall do what I can for God without my eyes.”

When life feels uncertain, Christ does not give us a road map, but He gives us Himself and His Spirit to serve one another undisturbed. Trusting Him, we discover who we are, and we become part of what He is building – a dynamic Church. Blessings! *Msgr. Xavier*

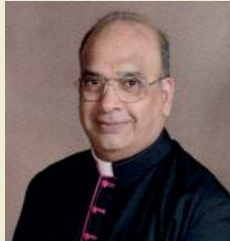

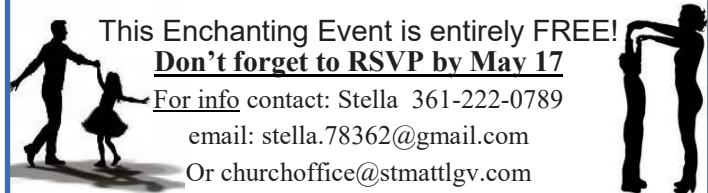

Dress Code: First Holy Communion & Confirmation

Girls: Dresses are NOT to be shorter than the knee or longer than the ankle. NO FORMALS. For those receiving First Holy Communion, the dress code is white; for the Confirmands, any color is permitted. Dress shoes or dress sandals (no tennis shoes). No dresses with spaghetti straps or without sleeves will be permitted. Without proper dress you may not be permitted to participate in the sacraments.

Boys: 1st Holy Communion: Dress shirt must be white, long or short sleeve. Dress pants may be white, navy blue or black. Ties - white, navy blue or black;

Boys: Confirmation: Dress shirt of any solid color. Dark dress pants - navy blue or black; (no tennis shoes); Suit coats or jackets are optional (not a requirement).

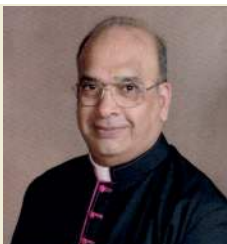

Llamados a servir con serenidad

Queridos hermanos y hermanas:

La vida suele definirse por las transiciones: mudanzas, cambios de empleo, la pérdida de seres queridos o el paso de una etapa vital a otra. Los discípulos se enfrentaban a la transición más importante de sus vidas: la partida de Jesús. Él les dice: «Me voy... no se turbe vuestro corazón». Les ofrece una hoja de ruta para el futuro: «Yo soy el Camino, la Verdad y la Vida», asegurándoles así su destino.

Él sopló sobre ellos y los convirtió en «piedras vivas» para edificar su Iglesia dinámica; a través de su santidad individual y de sus acciones, contribuyeron a la estabilidad y la belleza de toda la Iglesia y la comunidad. Él no desea que permanezcamos impasibles ante las dificultades, sino que no nos dejemos turbar por ellas. «En este mundo tendréis tribulación. ¡Pero tened ánimo...!» (Juan 16:33).

La Iglesia primitiva se enfrentó a un problema muy práctico en su vida cotidiana, el cual generaba tensiones entre los distintos grupos. Lo resolvieron mediante cambios estructurales y un liderazgo compartido. Designaron a siete diáconos para atender las necesidades prácticas del pueblo y servir a Dios, conformando así una Iglesia sinodal. La santidad no se limita a lo que ocurre en nuestros corazones; consiste también en cómo organizamos nuestras vidas para cuidar de los demás e incluir a todos en el seguimiento de «el Camino».

William Booth, fundador del Ejército de Salvación, perdió la vista en sus últimos años de vida. Solía decir: «He hecho cuanto he podido por Dios y por su pueblo valiéndome de mis ojos. Ahora haré cuanto pueda por Dios sin ellos». Cuando la vida se torna incierta, Cristo no nos entrega un mapa de carreteras; en su lugar, nos ofrece a Sí mismo y a su Espíritu para que nos sirvamos unos a otros con serenidad. Al confiar en Él, descubrimos nuestra verdadera identidad y pasamos a formar parte de aquello que Él está edificando: una Iglesia dinámica.

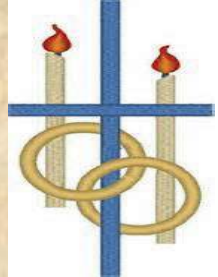
