In God’s Love, No Orphan

Dear brothers and sisters,
I wish all our mothers a Happy Mother’s Day! Also, let us pray for our deceased mothers that they may be in heaven and intercede for our well-being.

A mother’s love is often the closest human reflection of what God’s love is. It is not abstract or sentimental; it is lived out in countless quiet sacrifices, patient endurance, and faithful presence. Mothers “keep the commandments” of love not by quoting them, but by embodying them: in sleepless nights, in steady guidance, in forgiveness that never runs dry.

Jesus promises, “I will not leave you orphans.” That assurance resonates deeply today. Every mother, in her own way, becomes a sign of that promise. Through her care, a child learns what it means not to be abandoned, not to be forgotten. Even when imperfect, a mother’s love echoes God’s enduring presence. (Is. 49:15)

My priesthood also shares that same spiritual pattern. The Church has always understood the priest as a father, but also, mysteriously as one who carries a maternal dimension: nurturing souls, feeding them with the Eucharist, accompanying them in their struggles, and holding them in prayer, and forgiving them always. Like a mother, a priest’s love is often hidden, patient, and sacrificial.

On this day, I give thanks to God for 45 years of my priesthood. Like a mother who does not abandon her children, Christ has never abandoned me. If there has been any good in these 45 years, it is because His promise is true: “I will not leave you orphans... and I will be with you.” And I have simply tried, day by day, to be a sign of that presence. Thank you so much for being the companions of my priestly journey. Blessings!

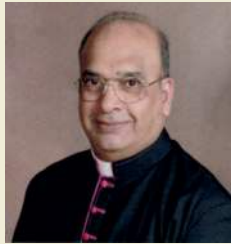

Dress Code: First Holy Communion & Confirmation

Girls: Dresses are NOT to be shorter than the knee or longer than the ankle. NO FORMALS. For those receiving First Holy Communion, the dress code is white; for the Confirmands, any color is permitted. Dress shoes or dress sandals (no tennis shoes). No dresses with spaghetti straps or without sleeves will be permitted. Without proper dress you may not be permitted to participate in the sacraments.

Boys: 1st Holy Communion: Dress shirt must be white, long or short sleeve. Dress pants may be white, navy blue or black. Ties - white, navy blue or black;

Boys: Confirmation: Dress shirt of any solid color. Dark dress pants - navy blue or black; (no tennis shoes); Suit coats or jackets are optional (not a requirement).

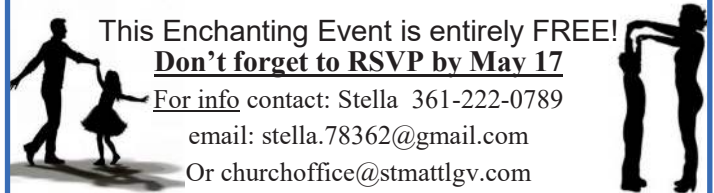

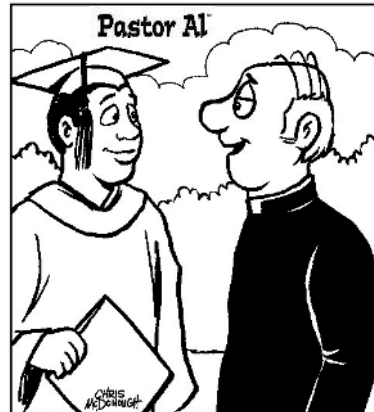

En el amor de Dios, nadie es huérfano.

Queridos hermanos, deseo a todas las madres un Feliz Día de la Madre. Recordemos a nuestras madres, tanto a las que viven como a las que ya han partido, y demos gracias a Dios, y a Su Madre, María, por ellas.

El amor de una madre es uno de los reflejos humanos más claros de lo que Jesús nos enseña. No es un amor abstracto, sino que se vive en el sacrificio silencioso, en la paciente perseverancia y en una presencia fiel. Las madres cumplen el mandamiento del amor con sus propias vidas: a través de noches de desvelo, de una guía constante y de un perdón inagotable.

Jesús nos promete: «No los dejaré huérfanos». Toda madre refleja esa promesa. A través de sus cuidados, el niño aprende lo que significa pertenecer y no ser olvidado. Incluso en medio de la imperfección, su amor hace eco de la presencia perdurable de Dios.

Mi sacerdocio participa de este mismo misterio. El sacerdote es llamado no solo a ser padre, sino también a manifestar una ternura maternal: nutriendo las almas, alimentándolas con la Eucaristía, caminando junto a ellas en sus luchas y sosteniéndolas en la oración. Al igual que el de una madre, este amor suele ser discreto, paciente y sacrificial.

Hoy doy gracias a Dios por mis 45 años de sacerdocio. Cristo nunca me ha abandonado. Si en mi vida ha habido algo bueno, ha sido porque Su promesa es verdadera: «No los dejaré huérfanos...Yo estoy con ustedes siempre». Yo simplemente he procurado ser un signo de esa presencia. Gracias por ser mis compañeros en este camino sacerdotal.

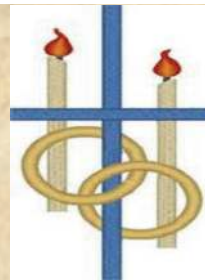
