His Absence is His Presence

Dear brothers and sisters,
 On the feast the Ascension of Jesus, may you and your family be blest by the Lord.

At first glance, it seems like a departure. Jesus goes “up,” and the disciples are left behind. But in truth, this is not an ending, it is a beginning for our life. The Ascension is

Not His Absence, but His Presence, a new mode of presence - not limited by time or place; He is present in the **Church**, the **Word**, and especially the **Eucharist**.

Young people often ask: “*What is my purpose?*” You are not too young to make a difference; your kindness, honesty, and courage are already part of God’s mission - in school, friendships, and family life - **reflecting Christ**. Your daily work is part of God’s plan; you evangelize not only with words, but with integrity and love in your work place, home, which are our mission fields.

Jesus goes up... but **He remains with us**; We go out... but we are never alone. Therefore, the angel’s words motivate us: “Don’t Just Look Up - Step Forward.” The disciples stopped staring at the sky and began changing the world.

A teacher spent years shaping her students - teaching not just lessons, but values. One day, she announced she was leaving. The class was heartbroken. “Who will guide us now?” She replied: “If I’ve taught you well, you already know what to do.” After she left, something surprising happened: students became more responsible; helped each other; and lived out what they had learned.

The Ascension is not Jesus leaving earth, it is Jesus trusting earth, the world, our family to us. Wherever you are in life: discover your mission; live your mission; and complete your mission in hope. It’s Jesus’ wish!

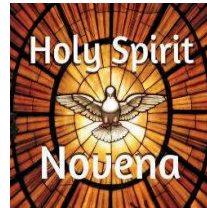

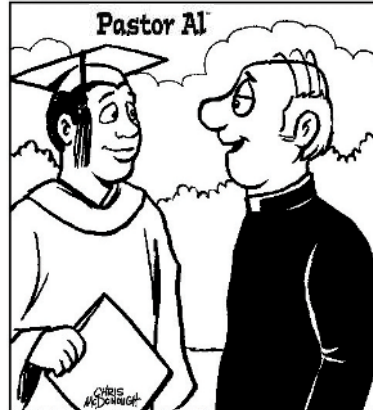

Su Ausencia es su Presencia

Queridos hermanos y hermanas:

En la fiesta de la Ascensión de Jesús, que el Señor bendiga a ustedes y a sus familias.

A primera vista parece una partida: Jesús asciende y los discípulos quedan atrás. Pero no es un final, sino un comienzo. La Ascensión no es ausencia, sino un nuevo modo de presencia, no limitado por el tiempo ni el espacio. Cristo permanece en la Iglesia, en la Palabra y especialmente en la Eucaristía.

Muchos jóvenes se preguntan: «¿Cuál es mi propósito?». No son demasiado jóvenes para hacer la diferencia. Su bondad, honestidad y valentía ya forman parte de la misión de Dios en la escuela, en la familia y en las amistades, reflejando a Cristo. Su vida cotidiana es misión: evangelizan con integridad y amor en el trabajo y en el hogar.

Jesús asciende, pero permanece con nosotros; nosotros salimos, pero no estamos solos. Por eso el ángel nos impulsa: «No se queden mirando al cielo; den un paso adelante». Los discípulos dejaron de mirar y comenzaron a transformar el mundo.

Una maestra formó durante años a sus alumnos, no solo en conocimientos, sino en valores. Un día anunció que se marchaba y la clase quedó desconsolada: «¿Quién nos guiará ahora?». Ella respondió: «Si les he enseñado bien, ustedes ya saben qué hacer». Tras su partida, los alumnos se volvieron más responsables, se ayudaban y pusieron en práctica lo aprendido.

La Ascensión no significa que Jesús abandone la tierra, sino que confía el mundo y nuestra familia a nuestras manos. En cualquier etapa de la vida: descubran, vivan y cumplan su misión con esperanza.

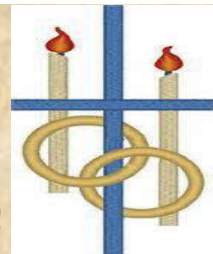
