## From Locked Room to Open World

Dear brothers and sisters,  
 On this Pentecost Day, the birthday of the Church, I wish you, a Happy Birth Day. You are the Church, and each of you make the Church family what she is.

The disciples are gathered in the upper room behind closed doors. Fear, uncertainty, and confusion still linger in their hearts. Though they had seen the Risen Lord; they were not yet ready to step into the world. Pentecost is not simply about receiving the Spirit; it is about being sent. The Spirit pushes the disciples outward, from silence to proclamation, from isolation to communion, from fear to courage. It is about becoming people who carry that fire into the world.

Reflecting the life of St. Francis of Assisi, who called the Holy Spirit, the “Minister General”, and insisted that the Holy Spirit was the true leader of his Franciscan Order, requiring his friars to walk in obedience to the Spirit. His conversion and ministry were guided by spiritual experience focusing on inner spiritual transformation.

Today many people still live in the “upper rooms.” Some are locked by disappointment, anxiety, selfishness, fear, prejudice, or indifference. Sometimes even the Church can become comfortable staying inside safe walls instead of reaching out to the wounded world. Pentecost challenges us not to remain enclosed within ourselves but open doors to go throughout the world to renew the face of the earth and witness the Gospel joy.

Pentecost continues whenever believers allow the Holy Spirit to renew them and send them forth into the world. The disciples did not remain in the upper room forever. Neither can we. The Holy Spirit calls us outward into our families, communities, and workplaces to become living witnesses of the Gospel. Blessings! - Msgr. Xavier

**Pro-Life: Fetal Development, Month 2**

The developing baby is now called a "fetus", which is Latin for "little one". She is making rapid progress developing all her organs. During the second month, baby teeth form, and fingers and toes are developing. Her ears, nose, lips and tongue can now be seen. Brain waves can be recorded. The skeleton changes from cartilage to bone. The central nervous system is now functioning, and so forty muscle sets begin their first exercises. By eight weeks, all body systems are present. This little one can now suck her thumb!

**Seven Effects of the Holy Communion**

- 1 Increases our union with Christ**  
 The flesh of the risen Christ increases our baptismal life of grace.
- 2 Separates us from sin**  
 The Eucharist cleanses past sins and preserves from future sins.
- 3 Wipes away venial sins**  
 The Eucharist gives us a living charity that wipes away venial sins.
- 4 Preserves us from future mortal sin**  
 The Eucharist is not directly ordered to the forgiveness of mortal sins. This is proper to the sacrament of Reconciliation.
- 5 Commits us to the poor**  
 By Communion, the person's baptismal incorporation into the Church is deepened.
- 6 Brings about the Unity of the Mystical Body**  
 Receiving Communion demands that we recognize Christ in the poor.
- 7 Brings about the unity of Christians**  
 The painful experience of Church division which breaks common Eucharistic participation makes our prayers for unity even more urgent.

### Del Cenáculo al Mundo Abierto

Queridos hermanos y hermanas:

En este día de Pentecostés —el cumpleaños de la Iglesia, les deseo un ¡feliz cumpleaños! Ustedes son la Iglesia, y cada uno de ustedes hace que la Iglesia-familia sea lo que es.

Los discípulos se encuentran reunidos en el Cenáculo, a puertas cerradas. El miedo, la incertidumbre y la confusión aún perduran en sus corazones, a pesar de haber visto al Señor Resucitado; todavía no estaban listos para salir al mundo. Pentecostés no consiste simplemente en recibir el Espíritu, sino en ser enviados. El Espíritu impulsa a los discípulos hacia afuera: del silencio a la proclamación, del aislamiento a la comunión, del miedo a la valentía. Se trata de convertirse en personas que llevan ese fuego al mundo.

Esto nos remite a la vida de San Francisco de Asís, quien llamaba al Espíritu Santo el «Ministro General» e insistía en que el Espíritu Santo era el verdadero líder de su Orden franciscana, exigiendo a sus frailes caminar en obediencia al Espíritu. Su conversión y su ministerio fueron guiados por una experiencia espiritual centrada en la transformación interior.

Hoy en día, muchas personas siguen viviendo en sus propios «cenáculos». Algunas permanecen encerradas por el miedo, la decepción, la ansiedad, el egoísmo, los prejuicios o la indiferencia. A veces, incluso la propia Iglesia puede acomodarse dentro de sus muros seguros, en lugar de salir al encuentro de un mundo herido. Pentecostés nos desafía a no permanecer encerrados en nosotros mismos, sino que nos abre las puertas para salir al mundo, renovar la faz de la tierra y dar testimonio de la alegría del Evangelio.

Pentecostés continúa cada vez que los creyentes permiten que el Espíritu Santo los renueve y los envíe al mundo. Los discípulos no permanecieron en el Cenáculo para siempre. Tampoco nosotros podemos hacerlo. El Espíritu Santo nos llama a salir hacia nuestras familias, nuestras comunidades y nuestros lugares de trabajo para convertirnos en testigos vivos del Evangelio.

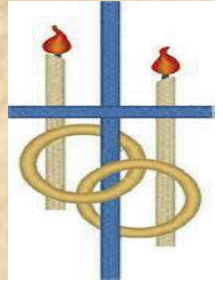
