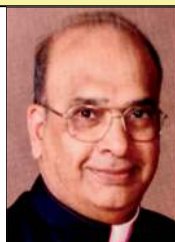

Life of Trinity IS Our Family Blueprint

Dear brothers and sisters,
Before there was creation, before there were human families, there was **relationship**. The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit—three Persons, one God—living in perfect unity, mutual self-giving, and love.

The Trinity is not a puzzle to be solved but a life to be entered, a pattern to imitate, and a mystery that shapes our identity. If we are made in the image of God, then we are made in the image of **communion or relationship**. The Holy Trinity offers a beautiful, practical blueprint for our own family lives.

Embrace Individuality: Just as the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are distinct, every member of your family has unique gifts, personalities, and temperaments. Trinitarian love doesn't force everyone to be the same; it celebrates who they are.

Cultivate Belonging: No one feels isolated; through family meals, shared prayers, and intentional quality time, we build a mini-trinity that echoes the divine fellowship, making room for the needs of others.

Daily Sacrifices: True love in a family is found in the quiet, unglamorous moments—doing the dishes when you're tired, or waking up in the middle of the night to care for others. The Holy Spirit is the glue that keeps you together when things get tough. He brings the fruits of patience, gentleness, and peace.

St. Francis recognized this divine relationship and sought to mirror it on earth; and every relationship was an opportunity to reflect the mutual respect and self-giving love of the Trinity. Your family is a small reflection of the Trinity that practices “THAT blueprint”. Thus, the Trinitarian life is the very heartbeat of Christian life.

Glory be to the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit who guides our daily life. Blessings! - Msgr. Xavier

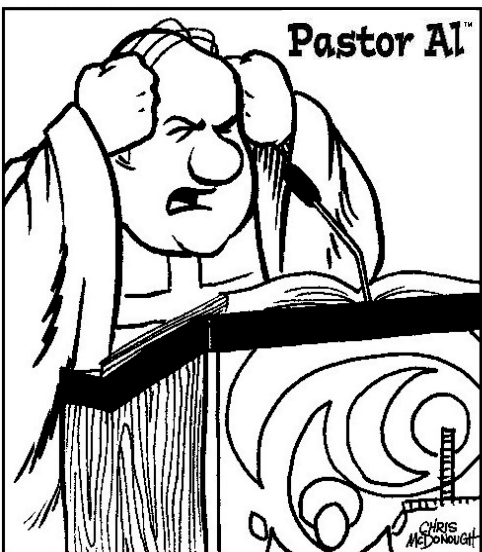

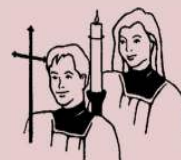

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

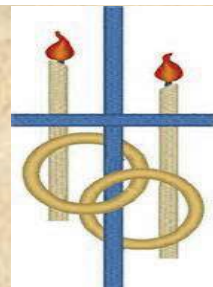
