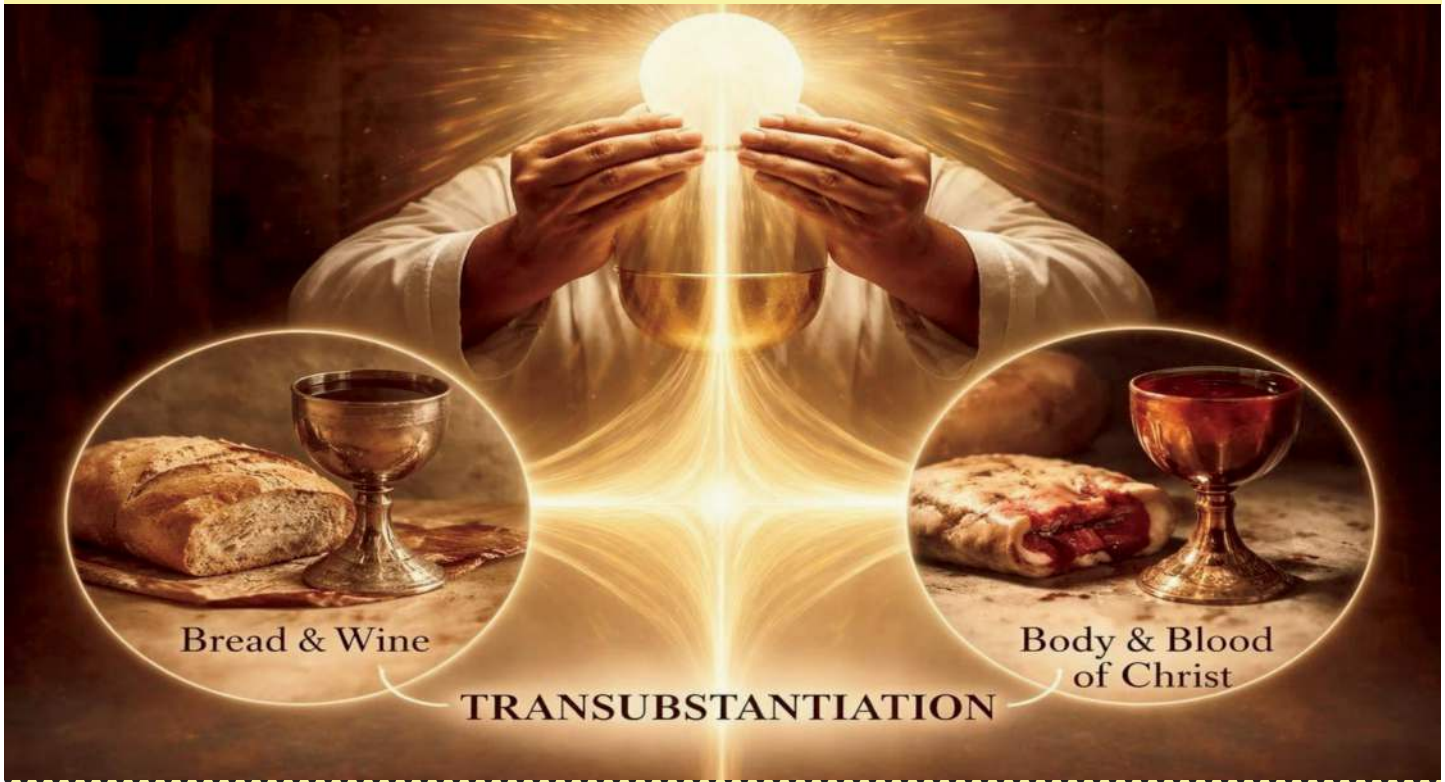

Not a Ritual but Real Presence

Dear brothers and sisters,

We celebrate the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. The Second Vatican Council powerfully stated, Eucharist is the **“source and summit of the whole Christian life.”** Without the Eucharist our faith becomes weak, prayer becomes dry, and charity loses its strength.

During the Mass, the bread and wine truly become the actual Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus Christ. It is an intimate, physical intimacy with God. When we receive the Eucharist, we are being sustained by Christ's own life, receiving the grace to love, forgive, and endure suffering.

We do not receive the Eucharist only for personal comfort or devotion; but for our lives may be transformed. The Eucharist strengthens us to love when it is difficult, to forgive when wounded, to serve without seeking reward, and to become instruments of peace in our families and communities.

Francis wept, preached, and wrote extensively about the immense humility of God hidden in a piece of bread; and he wrote: *“O sublime humility! That the Lord of the universe, God and the Son of God, so humbles Himself that for our salvation He hides Himself under the little form of bread!”* He says, Jesus continues to choose to humble Himself every single day, coming down into the hands of a priest and entering our imperfect bodies.

He begged his friars to show the utmost respect to priests—not because of their personal holiness, but because their hands alone had the power to bring the Body and Blood of Christ into the world. He could not understand how people could remain indifferent before such a mystery. The Eucharist is not a routine or ritual; it is heaven touching the earth. Let us experience His REAL presence intimately. Blessings! - Msgr. Xavier

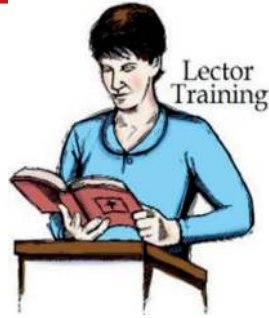

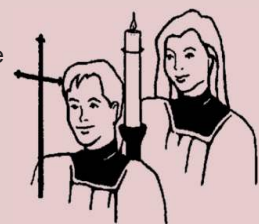

No un Ritual, Sino una Realidad

Queridos hermanos y hermanas:

Celebramos el Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Jesucristo. El Concilio Vaticano II afirmó con fuerza que la Eucaristía es la «fuente y cumbre de toda la vida cristiana». Sin la Eucaristía, nuestra fe se debilita, la oración se vuelve árida y la caridad pierde su fuerza.

Durante la Misa, el pan y el vino se convierten verdaderamente en el Cuerpo, la Sangre, el Alma y la Divinidad reales de Jesucristo. Es una intimidad, una intimidad física con Dios. Cuando recibimos la Eucaristía, somos sostenidos por la propia vida de Cristo, recibiendo la gracia para amar, perdonar y soportar el sufrimiento.

No recibimos la Sagrada Comunión únicamente para nuestro consuelo personal o por devoción, sino para que nuestras vidas sean transformadas. La Eucaristía nos fortalece para amar cuando resulta difícil, para perdonar cuando hemos sido heridos, para servir sin buscar recompensa y para convertirnos en instrumentos de paz en nuestras familias y comunidades.

Francisco lloró, predicó y escribió extensamente sobre la inmensa humildad de Dios, oculta en un trozo de pan; y escribió: «¡Oh sublime humildad! ¡Que el Señor del universo, Dios e Hijo de Dios, se humille tanto que, para nuestra salvación, se oculte bajo la pequeña forma del pan!».

Él afirma que Jesús sigue eligiendo humillarse cada día, descendiendo a las manos de un sacerdote y entrando en nuestros cuerpos imperfectos. Rogaba a sus frailes que mostraran el máximo respeto a los sacerdotes, no por su santidad personal, sino porque solo sus manos tenían el poder de traer al mundo el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo. No lograba comprender cómo las personas podían permanecer indiferentes ante semejante misterio.

La Eucaristía no es una rutina ni un ritual; es el cielo tocando la tierra. Experimentemos Su presencia REAL.

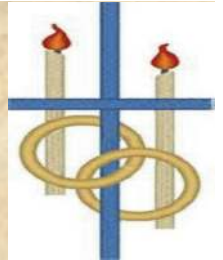
