Dear brothers and sisters,
God chose people of Israel and entered into a covenant with them: "You shall be my special possession, ...so that through you all nations may come to know the living God." His chosen people are to mediate God's presence to the world.

Jesus' heart was moved in compassion and called the Twelve Apostles, and sent them out to the people "troubled and abandoned, like sheep without a shepherd" to care, to heal the sick, to cleanse lepers, and to proclaim the Kingdom of God.

Jesus did not wait for his Apostles to become perfectly fit and worthy. He empowered them to love, forgive, and reconcile. He saw them, sanctified them and sent them to His people; I will be with you always [Mt. 28:20]; and the Spirit will teach about everything I told you [Jn. 14:26].

Like Israel and the Apostles, we are chosen. We have become God's chosen and special people [1 Pet. 2:9]; not because we are perfect. We are ordinary men/women with weaknesses and fears. Yet Jesus entrusts you and me with His mission – to be His presence among our families, neighbors, workplaces, and communities to care.

Think of a mail carrier: he/she does not create the message; he faithfully delivers it. Likewise, Christians are called to deliver God's message of love, mercy, truth, and hope without changing it with compassion. We are not the source of the Gospel; we are its messengers.

Someone said, "Though our task is not to bring all the world to Christ, our task is unquestionably to bring Christ to the world." I would say, "bring Christ to YOUR world"- your family, your coworkers and your friends.

We are in the world with the THAT mission or purpose!

Vistos, Santificados y Enviados

Queridos hermanos y hermanas:

Dios eligió al pueblo de Israel y estableció una alianza con ellos: «Ustedes serán mi posesión especial... para que, a través de ustedes, todas las naciones lleguen a conocer al Dios vivo». Su pueblo elegido tiene la misión de hacer presente a Dios ante el mundo.

El corazón de Jesús se conmovió de compasión; llamó a los Doce Apóstoles y los envió al encuentro de la gente «atormentada y desamparada, como ovejas sin pastor» para cuidarla, sanar a los enfermos, purificar a los leprosos y proclamar la llegada del Reino de Dios.

Jesús no esperó a que sus Apóstoles fueran perfectamente aptos y dignos. Les otorgó el poder para amar, perdonar y reconciliar. Él los vio, los santificó y los envió a su pueblo, diciéndoles: «Yo estaré siempre con ustedes» [Mt 28:20] y «el Espíritu les enseñará todo lo que yo les he dicho» [Jn 14:26].

Al igual que Israel y los Apóstoles, nosotros hemos sido elegidos. Nos hemos convertido en el pueblo elegido y especial de Dios [1 Pe 2:9]; no porque seamos perfectos, sino porque somos hombres y mujeres comunes, con nuestras debilidades y temores. Sin embargo, Jesús nos confía —a ti y a mí— su misión: ser su presencia en medio de nuestras familias, vecinos, lugares de trabajo y comunidades, para brindar cuidado y atención.

Piensen en un cartero: él no crea el mensaje, sino que lo entrega fielmente. Del mismo modo, los cristianos estamos llamados a entregar el mensaje de Dios — un mensaje de amor, misericordia, verdad y esperanza — sin alterarlo, y a hacerlo con compasión. Nosotros no somos la fuente del Evangelio; somos sus mensajeros.

Alguien dijo una vez: «Aunque nuestra tarea no sea llevar al mundo entero hacia Cristo, nuestra tarea es, indudablemente, llevar a Cristo al mundo». Yo añadiría: «llevar a Cristo a TU mundo»: a tu familia, a tus compañeros de trabajo. Estamos en el mundo precisamente con esa misión, con ese propósito! ¡Bendiciones! - Mons. Xavier

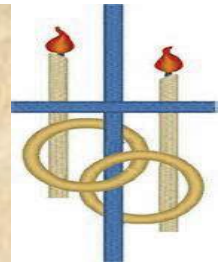
