

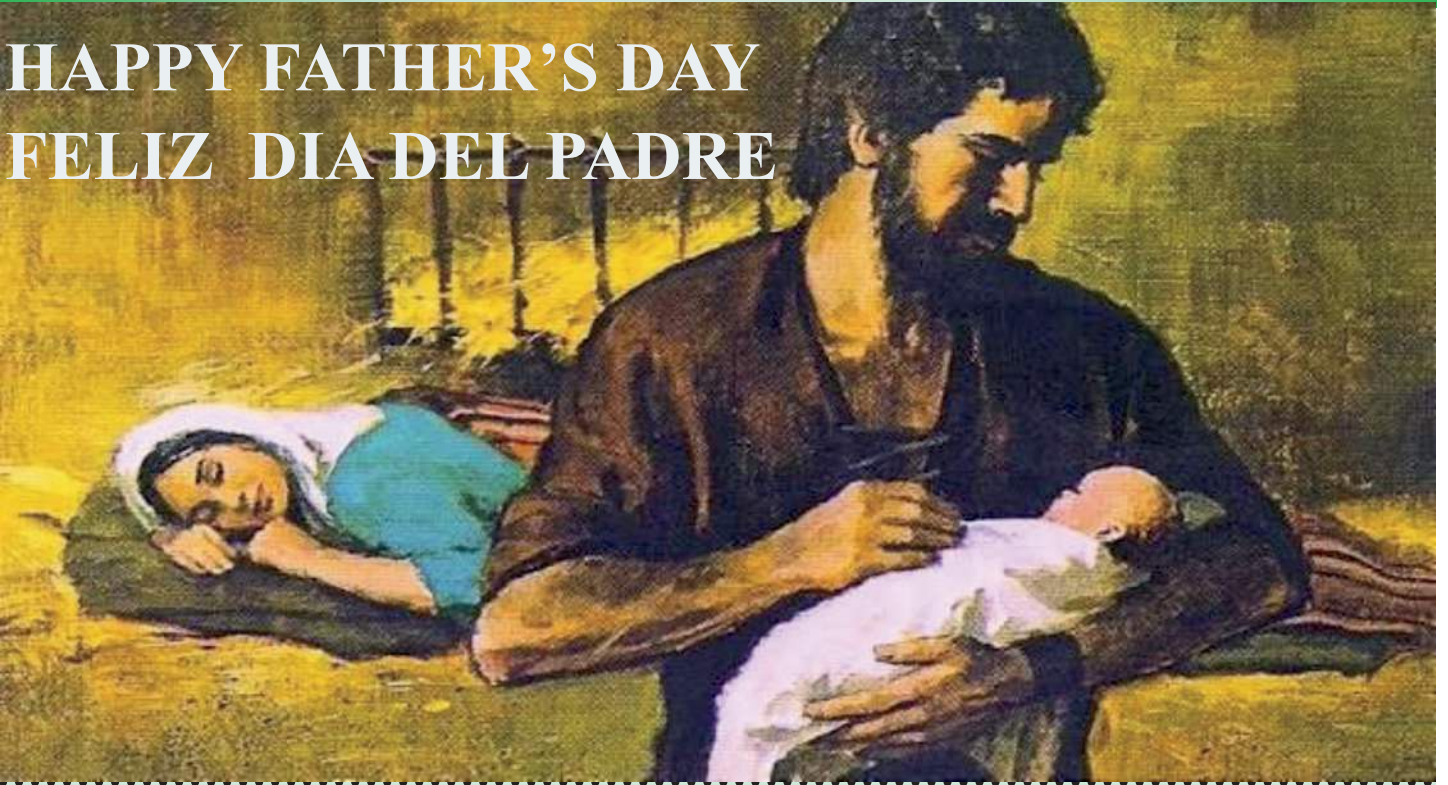

Fearless Faith in a Fearful World

Dear brothers and sisters,
 Two explorers in a jungle saw a ferocious lion who jumped in front of them. "Keep calm." the first whispered. "Remember what we read in that book on wild animals? If you stand perfectly still and look the lion in the eye, he will turn and run." "Sure," replied his friend, "You've read the book and I've read the book. But has the lion read the book?" The world does not know or fear God. How do we face it?

Every faithful father of a family teaches his children to live fearlessly in this godless world surrounded by conflict and challenges that can shake our confidence. Just like St. Joseph, a godly father is not one who never experiences fear, but who trusts God amid uncertainty and leads his family by example.

Prophet Jeremiah faced rejection, ridicule and threats because he was a man of God. He shows us that courage is not the absence of fear but the willingness to place our trust in God even when life is difficult.

Jesus assures us that God knows and cares for us so deeply that even the hairs on our heads are counted. Fear loses its power when we remember that we are loved and protected by God. God's message to us is clear: **"Do not be afraid."**

St. Francis, in times of misunderstanding, hardship, and poverty, placed his life in God's hands and discovered true freedom and joy. Someone said, **"We fear men so much because we fear God so little."**

As we honor our fathers, let us thank God for their sacrifices and pray that they may be strengthened in faith and courage to face whatever lies ahead. Keep your fears to yourself; share your courage with others.

THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN:



DIOCESAN

A diocesan priest is called to serve the local community of Christians, as a Spiritual Father, of a local parish in a geographical region called a Diocese.

At his ordination, a diocesan priest makes the three promises of a life of prayer, respect and obedience to his bishop and successors, and of celibacy.



RELIGIOUS

Religious Order priests are first called to be Religious Brothers in the Consecrated Life, where a man consecrates himself to Christ through the three Evangelical Counsels, through making the vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience.

The overall mission of the Religious Order priest is to live consecrated life well, in a particular community, following the particular charism (or holy activity) of the particular religious order.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas:

Dos amigos que recorrían la selva vieron cómo un le3n feroz saltaba frente a ellos. «Mantén la calma», susurró el primero. «¿Recuerdas lo que leímos en aquel libro sobre animales salvajes? Si te quedas completamente quieto y miras al le3n a los ojos, se dará la vuelta y huirá». «Claro», respondió su amigo, «tú has leído el libro y yo he leído el libro. Pero ¿ha leído el libro el le3n?». El mundo no conoce a Dios ni le teme. ¿Cómo afrontamos esta realidad?

San Francisco, en tiempos de adversidad, pobreza e incomprensi3n, puso su vida en manos de Dios y descubrió la verdadera libertad y alegrí3a. Alguien dijo: «Tememos tanto a los hombres porque tememos tan poco a Dios».

Al honrar a nuestros padres, demos gracias a Dios por sus sacrificios y oremos para que se fortalezcan en la fe y tengan valor para afrontar lo que les depare el futuro. Guarda tus miedos para ti mismo; comparte tu valentía con los demás. ¡Feliz Día del Padre!

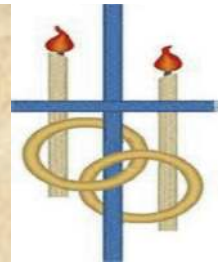
