Divine Patience and Human Endurance

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,
Have you ever prayed, "Lord, why don't You do something?" Why not stop wars, remove evil, or heal every illness? We live in an age of "instant"—instant messages, instant coffee, overnight delivery, yet God's timetable is very different. **God is never in a hurry, but He is never late.** His timing is guided by wisdom, mercy, and love.

We are alive today because of God's patience. Think about your own life. How many times have you failed and asked for forgiveness? Yet God has never said, "I've had enough of you." That is divine patience. As Pope Francis reminded us, "God never tires of forgiving us."

In today's Gospel, the farmer does not pull up the weeds because what looks like a weed today may become healthy wheat tomorrow. That is how God looks at us. Imagine if God had given up on St. Peter after he denied Jesus, on St. Paul when he persecuted Christians, or on St. Augustine during his years away from God. None of them would have become saints. God's patience changed history.

Every family has both wheat and weeds. Parents worry about children who drift from the faith. Husbands and wives carry old wounds. Siblings become divided. The temptation is to give up. But Jesus tells us: **Wait. Pray.** God may still be growing wheat where we only see weeds. This is our call to **patient endurance**.

We are not alone: the Holy Spirit comes to help us in our weakness, the place where God's grace begins to work. Let us reflect God's patience in our homes, our parish, and our community. May our families become places where God's patience and our patient endurance is revealed everyday!

The Difference Between Sacrament Preparation & Faith Formation

Sacrament Preparation:

Purpose: To prepare individuals to receive a specific sacrament (such as Baptism, First Communion, Confirmation, Reconciliation, or Marriage).

Focus: Understanding the meaning and importance of the specific sacrament. Learning the rites, prayers and traditions associated with it. Spiritual and moral readiness to receive the sacrament.

Faith Formation

Purpose: To nurture and deepen a person's lifelong relationship with God and understanding of the faith.

Focus: Broad teaching of Christian doctrine, of Scripture, prayer, moral living, and Church teachings. Encouraging a personal and communal life of faith. Supporting spiritual growth over time.

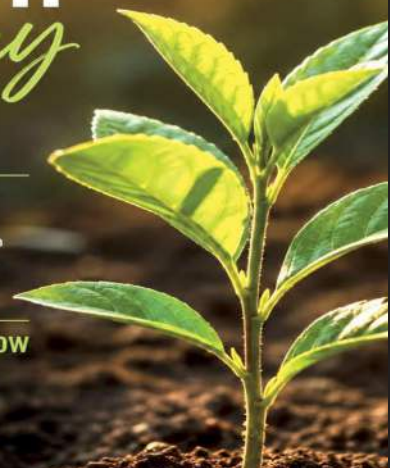

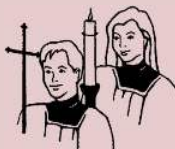

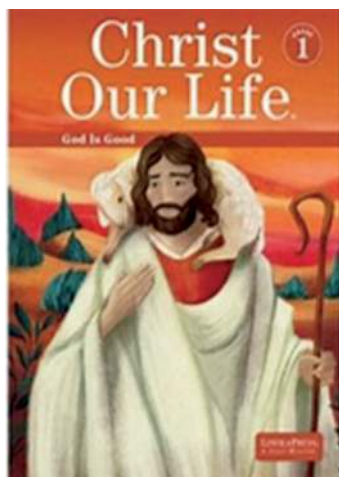

5 Powerful Ways [after a retreat] to Keep Your Heart on Fire for God

Is your heart on fire for God? Yes, after this "mountaintop experience" during the retreat, your heart is full of love & joy.
How to grow & glow in it!

1. Pray Daily: To keep your faith burning bright, start with the basics – prayer. Regular communication with Him will help keep the passion for Him burning. Even if you don't know how to pray, ask God to fill your heart with a desire and hunger for more of Him.
2. Read and meditate on God's Word. (Read the daily Mass readings) When you meditate the Word becomes alive in you. Remember the example of the Emmaus Disciples. (Lk. 24:32) Their hearts were burning within them. Read Psalm 1:2-3; and Rom. 10:17.
3. Serve Others: Whenever I serve others, I always get a joyful feeling inside. Join one of the ministries in the church. People go for mission trips and come back fully on fire. For God. Be the hands and feet of Jesus to set your heart on fire for God. When you follow Christ's example and serve other people, you will see God's love in action and it will stir your heart closer to God's. Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord. [Romans 12:11]
4. Fellowship with Others who are on fire for God. Surround yourself and fellowship with other believers. It is so important to our faith walk. Try to attend a weekly group through the church and always leave feeling fired up for God.
5. Share the good news to a non-believer everyday. Choose a different non-believer and make an effort to share your love for God. Thus, you will be rekindling your faith putting off your old self and taking up your new identity. Jesus fills your heart and sets on fire to glorify Him.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

¿Alguna vez han preguntado: "Señor, ¿por qué no haces algo?" Vivimos en una cultura de lo inmediato, pero Dios actúa según su tiempo perfecto, guiado por la sabiduría, la misericordia y el amor. Jesús nos invita a no rendirnos, sino a esperar, orar y amar. Puede que Dios esté haciendo crecer trigo allí donde nosotros solo vemos mala hierba. Este es nuestro llamado a la perseverancia paciente. No estamos solos: el Espíritu Santo viene en nuestra ayuda, y nuestra debilidad se convierte en el lugar donde la gracia de Dios comienza a actuar.

Pidamos al Señor que reflejemos su paciencia en nuestros hogares, parroquias y comunidades, haciendo de ellas lugares donde la misericordia venza a la ira, el perdón al resentimiento, la esperanza a la desesperación y el amor a toda debilidad.

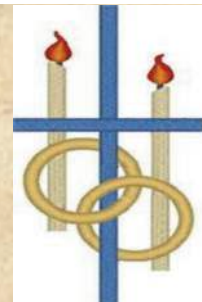
