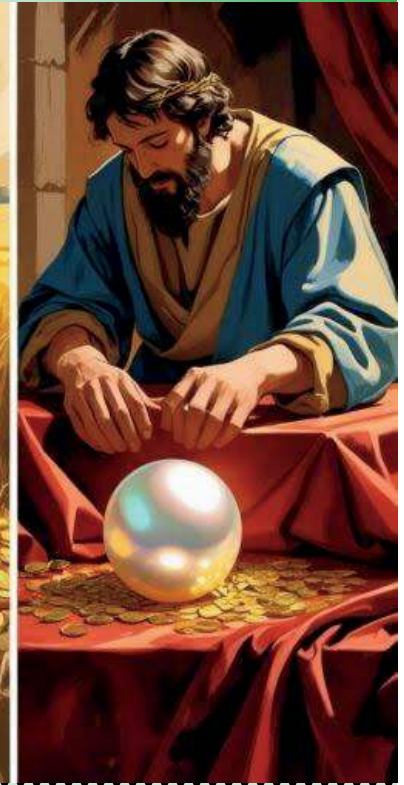

Listening to & from Your Heart

Dear brothers and sisters,

To have a "listening heart" is to live in a continuous, quiet readiness to be moved by God. It is an active choice to tune out the world's cacophony so we might hear the steady heartbeat of the Creator.

A listening heart: Solomon stood at the threshold of greatness, yet recognized he lacked the essential tool for his calling: an understanding heart. He did not ask for power, wealth, or fame. He asked for a listening heart.

A humble heart: a listening heart begins with the humility of admitting, "I do not know the way, but I know the One who does." Wisdom is not bought or learned from books; it is received. Asking for wisdom, admits our limitations, creating space for God's infinite perspective.

A trusting heart: St. Paul's promise that all things work for good is an invitation to radical trust, not a platitude to dismiss suffering. It is the courage to stand in life's turbulence and whisper, "You are still holding the pen." Mother Teresa trusted completely, calling herself "a little pencil in God's hands."

A discerning heart: the merchant and the man in the field traded the temporary for the eternal. A listening heart recognizes the incomparable value of the kingdom, and we choose it not because we are forced to, but because we see its worth.

To live with a listening heart is to live awake. it is to approach each day not as a battle or a test, but as a conversation. May we never be too busy to listen, too proud to ask, or too attached to the world to let go. May our hearts remain tuned to the frequency of His grace.

Someone said, "You'll never find peace of mind until you have learned to listen with your heart."

The Difference Between Sacrament Preparation & Faith Formation Sacrament Preparation:

Purpose: To prepare individuals to receive a specific sacrament (such as Baptism, First Holy Communion, Confirmation, Reconciliation, or Marriage).

Focus: Understanding the meaning and importance of the specific sacrament. Learning the rites, prayers and traditions associated with it. Spiritual and moral readiness to receive the sacrament.

Faith Formation

Purpose: To nurture and deepen a person's lifelong relationship with God and understanding of the faith.

Focus: Broad teaching of Christian doctrine, Scripture, prayer, moral living, and Church teachings. Encouraging a personal and communal life of faith so as to support spiritual growth over time.

Why Ages 2-7 Matter? Why must I register?

So much for brain development!
This first critical period of brain development begins around age 2 and concludes around age 7.

It provides a prime opportunity to lay the foundation for a holistic education for children.

Four ways to maximize this critical period include encouraging a love of learning, focusing on breadth instead of depth, paying attention to emotional intelligence, and not treating young children's education as merely a precursor to "real" learning.

Don't delay your child's learning!

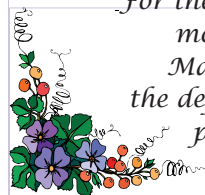

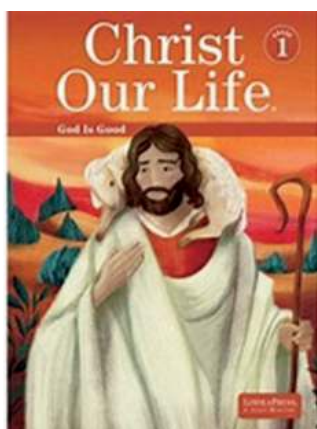

5 Powerful Ways [after a retreat] to Keep Your Heart on Fire for God

Is your heart on fire for God? Yes, after this "mountaintop experience" during the retreat, your heart is full of love & joy.
How to grow & glow in it!

1. Pray Daily: To keep your faith burning bright, start with the basics – prayer. Regular communication with Him will help keep the passion for Him burning. Even if you don't know how to pray, ask God to fill your heart with a desire and hunger for more of Him.

2. Read and meditate on God's Word. (Read the daily Mass readings) When you meditate, the Word becomes alive in you. Remember the example of the Emmaus Disciples. (Lk. 24:32) Their hearts were burning within them. Read Psalm 1:2-3; and Rom. 10:17.

3. Serve Others: Whenever I serve others, I always get a joyful feeling inside. Join one of the ministries in the church. People go for mission trips and come back fully on fire for God. Be the hands and feet of Jesus to set your heart on fire for God. When you follow Christ's example and serve other people, you will see God's love in action and it will stir your heart closer to God's. Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord. [Romans 12:11]

4. Fellowship with Others who are on fire for God. Surround yourself and fellowship with other believers. It is so important to our faith walk. Try to attend a weekly group through the church and always leave feeling fired up for God.

5. Share the good news to a non-believer everyday. Choose a different non-believer and make an effort to share your love for God. Thus, you will be rekindling your faith putting off your old self and taking up your new identity. Jesus fills your heart and sets it on fire to glorify Him.

Escucha a Tu / Desde Tu Corazón

Queridos hermanos y hermanas:

Tener un "corazón que escucha" es vivir en una disposición continua y serena para dejarse conmover por Dios. Es una elección activa de silenciar la cacofonía del mundo para poder escuchar el latido constante del Creador. Un corazón que escucha: Salomón se encontraba en el umbral de la grandeza, pero reconoció que carecía de la herramienta esencial para su vocación: un corazón comprensivo. No pidió poder, o riqueza; pidió un corazón que escucha.

Un corazón humilde: Un corazón que escucha comienza con la humildad de admitir: "No conozco el camino, pero conozco a Aquel que sí lo conoce". La sabiduría no se compra ni se aprende en los libros; se recibe. Pedir sabiduría implica reconocer nuestras limitaciones, creando así espacio para la perspectiva infinita de Dios.

Un corazón confiado: La promesa de San Pablo de que todo obra para el bien es una invitación a una confianza radical, no un lugar común para restar importancia al sufrimiento. Es el valor de mantenerse firme ante las turbulencias de la vida y susurrar: "Tú sigues sosteniendo la pluma". La Madre Teresa confiaba plenamente y se describía a sí misma como "un pequeño lápiz en las manos de Dios".

Un corazón que discierne: El comerciante y el hombre del campo cambiaron lo temporal por lo eterno. Un corazón que escucha reconoce el valor incomparable del Reino. Lo elegimos no porque estemos obligados a hacerlo, sino porque vemos su valor.

Vivir con un corazón que escucha es vivir despierto. Es afrontar cada día no como una batalla o una prueba, sino como una conversación. Que nunca estemos demasiado ocupados para escuchar, demasiado orgullosos para preguntar o demasiado apegados al mundo para soltar lo que nos retiene. Que nuestros corazones permanezcan sintonizados con la frecuencia de su gracia. Alguien dijo: "Nunca encontrarás paz mental hasta que hayas aprendido a escuchar a tu corazón". ¡Bendiciones! — Mons. 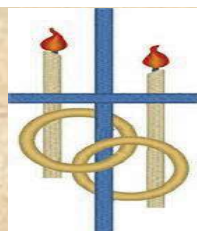
