Blest to be the Blessing

Dear brothers and sisters,

God has been generous blessing us not for our own comfort but to bless and feed others with His love and compassion.

God invites us, *"Come to the water... Come, receive grain and eat without paying and without cost."* He welcomes everyone—rich or poor, worthy or unworthy. His grace is free. *"Why spend your money for what is not bread and for what fails to satisfy?"* Many people today try to satisfy their deepest hunger with success, possessions, pleasure, or recognition. These things can't fill our hearts. Only God can satisfy our deepest hunger.

When Jesus sees the hungry people, He sees opportunity to feed; but the disciples see only a problem: *"We have only five loaves and two fish."* Jesus sees an opportunity for grace. Then He tells the disciples: **"Give them some food yourselves."** – share your grace or blessing. Jesus could have fed the crowd without them, but He chose to involve them. He took their small offering, blessed it, multiplied it, and gave it back to them to share.

This is how God still works today. He asks us to bring what we have - our compassion, time, talents, and resources - and He multiplies them for the good of others. Our greatest nourishment is not merely food but the blessings we enjoy and experience from God.

Every night we plug in our phones because we know that if the battery is empty, the phone cannot function. We don't charge it just to admire a full battery - we charge it so it can be used. Our spiritual life is the same. We are being "recharged" by God's Word and the Eucharist. If we leave that grace unused, we have missed the purpose.

We are fed so that we can go into our homes, places of work and communities, carrying Christ's love. You are blest. Be a blessing to all.

The Difference Between Sacrament Preparation & Faith Formation

Sacrament Preparation:

Purpose: To prepare individuals to receive a specific sacrament (such as Baptism, First Holy Communion, Confirmation, Reconciliation, or Marriage).

Focus: Understanding the meaning and importance of the specific sacrament. Learning the rites, prayers and traditions associated with it. Spiritual and moral readiness to receive the sacrament.

Faith Formation

Purpose: To nurture and deepen a person's lifelong relationship with God and understanding of the faith.

Focus: Broad teaching of Christian doctrine, Scripture, prayer, moral living, and Church teachings. Encouraging a personal and communal life of faith so as to support spiritual growth over time.

Why Ages 2-7 Matter? Why must I register?

So much for brain development!
This first critical period of brain development begins around age 2 and concludes around age 7.

It provides a prime opportunity to lay the foundation for a holistic education for children.

Four ways to maximize this critical period include encouraging a love of learning, focusing on breadth instead of depth, paying attention to emotional intelligence, and not treating young children's education as merely a precursor to "real" learning.

Don't delay your child's learning!

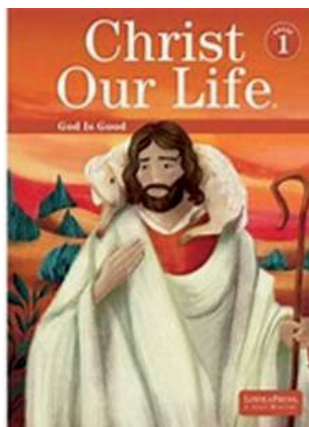

5 Powerful Ways [after a retreat] to Keep Your Heart on Fire for God

Is your heart on fire for God? Yes, after this "mountaintop experience" during the retreat, your heart is full of love & joy. How to grow & glow in it!

1. Pray Daily: To keep your faith burning bright, start with the basics – prayer. Regular communication with Him will help keep the passion for Him burning. Even if you don't know how to pray, ask God to fill your heart with a desire and hunger for more of Him.

2. Read and meditate on God's Word. (Read the daily Mass readings) When you meditate, the Word becomes alive in you. Remember the example of the Emmaus Disciples. (Lk. 24:32) Their hearts were burning within them. Read Psalm 1:2-3; and Rom. 10:17.

3. Serve Others: Whenever I serve others, I always get a joyful feeling inside. Join one of the ministries in the church. People go for mission trips and come back fully on fire for God. Be the hands and feet of Jesus to set your heart on fire for God. When you follow Christ's example and serve other people, you will see God's love in action and it will stir your heart closer to God's. Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord. [Romans 12:11]

4. Fellowship with Others who are on fire for God. Surround yourself and fellowship with other believers. It is so important to our faith walk. Try to attend a weekly group through the church and always leave feeling fired up for God.

5. Share the good news to a non-believer everyday. Choose a different non-believer and make an effort to share your love for God. Thus, you will be rekindling your faith putting off your old self and taking up your new identity. Jesus fills your heart and sets it on fire to glorify Him.

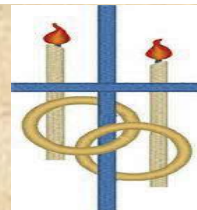
