Faith Beyond Boundaries

Dear brothers and sisters,

We often build walls of race, nationality, language, religion, social status, politics, or culture. God, however, continually breaks down those walls.

The prophet Isaiah speaks to foreigners, once considered outsiders to God's covenant and declares: "My house shall be called a house of prayer for ALL peoples"; none excluded.

St. Paul says, "God has imprisoned all in disobedience that He may have mercy upon all." Jews need mercy. Gentiles need mercy. Saints need mercy. Sinners need mercy. God's love is not limited by our failures or imperfections because His mercy is greater than our sins.

Jesus meets a pagan woman who pleads for God's mercy. Jesus tested her faith – rejecting and humiliating her. She proved her faith and need for mercy. She broke the barriers - not her nationality or race but her faith. Jesus crossed the boundary and extended His grace.

A crowded beach suddenly erupts in panic. A child is caught in a dangerous current. The lifeguard does not first ask: "What nationality is the child?" Or "What religion does the family practice? Are they rich or poor? Are they citizens or visitors?" He dives in immediately because a life is in danger. Love acts before it categorizes. That is how God loves us.

The Church should never become a private club for the "already faithful." It is God's home for every person searching for Him. Our parish should reflect heaven, where people "from every nation, race, people, and tongue" gather before God. (Rev.7:9)

The Eucharist gathers people from every nation, language, and culture into one family of God. Let's break barriers with our faith.

Focus: Broad teaching of Christian doctrine, Scripture, prayer, moral living, and Church teachings. Encouraging a personal and communal life of faith so as to support spiritual growth over time.

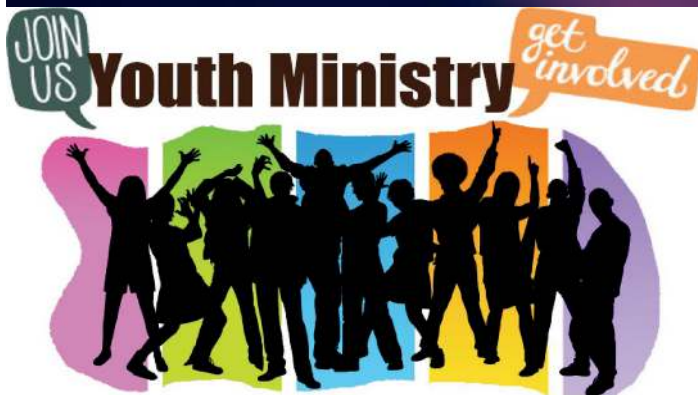

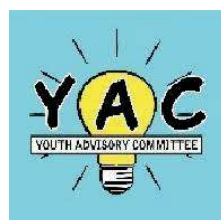

Fe Más Allá de las Fronteras

Queridos hermanos y hermanas:

A menudo levantamos muros de raza, nacionalidad, idioma, religión, estatus social, política o cultura. Dios, sin embargo, derriba continuamente esos muros.

El profeta Isaías se dirige a los extranjeros, a quienes antes se consideraba ajenos a la alianza de Dios. Sin embargo, Dios declara: «Mi casa será llamada casa de oración para TODOS los pueblos», sin excluir a nadie

San Pablo dice: «Dios encerró a todos en la desobediencia para tener misericordia de todos». Los judíos necesitan misericordia. Los gentiles necesitan misericordia. Los santos necesitan misericordia. Los pecadores necesitan misericordia. El amor de Dios no está limitado por nuestros fracasos o imperfecciones, porque su misericordia es mayor que nuestros pecados.

Jesús se encuentra con una mujer pagana que implora la misericordia de Dios. Jesús puso a prueba su fe, rechazándola y humillándola. Ella demostró su fe y su necesidad de misericordia. Rompió las barreras; no por su nacionalidad o raza, sino por su fe. Jesús cruzó la frontera y le ofreció su gracia.

Una playa abarrotada estalla de repente en pánico. Un niño ha quedado atrapado en una corriente peligrosa. El socorrista no pregunta primero: ¿De qué nacionalidad es el niño? ¿Qué religión practica la familia? ¿Son ricos o pobres? ¿Son ciudadanos o visitantes? Se lanza al agua de inmediato porque una vida está en peligro. El amor actúa antes de clasificar. Así es como Dios nos ama.

La Iglesia nunca debe convertirse en un club privado para los «ya fieles». Es el hogar de Dios para toda persona que lo busca. Nuestra parroquia debe reflejar el cielo, donde personas «de toda nación, raza, pueblo y lengua» se reúnen ante Dios (Apocalipsis 7:9).

La Eucaristía reúne a personas de toda nación, idioma y cultura en una sola familia de Dios. Rompamos las barreras con nuestra fe. ¡Bendiciones y oraciones! - Mons. Xavier

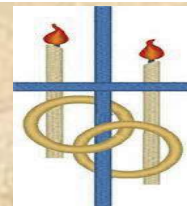

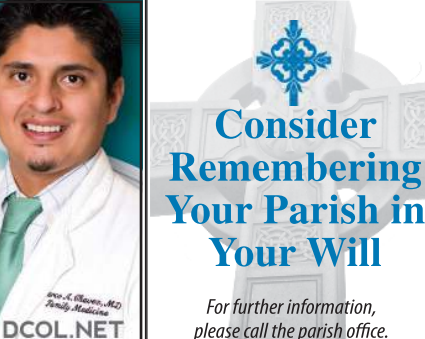
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
