Power Vs Authority

Dear brothers and sisters,
Human power seeks to dominate, and preserve itself through control and force. Conversely, Divine Authority, operates entirely through the logic of Grace. Look at the fate of Shebna, the master of the palace. He is a man intoxicated by human power. He carves out a majestic tomb for himself in the rock, engineering his own legacy, confident in his political security. God strips him of his office; and elevates Eliakim to the power for his faithful stewardship.

Peter, who is not a polished politician, master strategist, or religious dictator, but an impulsive, fragile fisherman, is given the divine authority, the keys of the Kingdom for his faithfulness to Christ. While Shebna carved his tomb on a rock, Christ builds His Church on a "Rock".

God does not need our human posturing, our resume of strengths, or our self-made kingdoms, but our surrender. Peter becomes a pillar precisely because he stops relying on his own human power and opens himself up to divine grace. Authority is given by God. (Jn. 19:10-11); authority to serve and power to protect.

By building our own "Shebna Tombs", we will not understand divine authority. *"The depth of the riches, wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are his judgments and how inscrutable his ways!"* Entrust your life to His authority, and let Him build something eternal on the foundation of a humble heart.

An empty work glove with the shape of fingers, cannot pick up a tool or move by itself. A living hand slides inside the glove. Now the glove does hard work, but only because the hand gives it power and direction. Human strength alone achieves nothing of eternal value. God's authority works best when human lives let His Spirit move through them. (Isaiah 10:15). Blessings! - Msgr. Xavier

This month marks the half-way point to birth, and the baby is very active. Sleep habits develop and his mother can feel him move and stretch, particularly when she is resting. He is big and strong enough to kick hard against the outside uterine wall and dent it. Up to now, although he swam with ease in his watery world, he was too small for her to detect because the wall of the uterus has little feeling. Babies born at this age have survived. 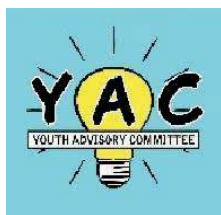

Autoridad Divina y Poder Humano

Queridos hermanos y hermanas:

El poder humano busca dominar y preservarse mediante el control y la fuerza. Por el contrario, la autoridad divina opera bajo la lógica de la gracia.

Observen el destino de Sebna, administrador del palacio. Es un hombre embriagado por el poder humano. Se labra una tumba majestuosa en la roca, pensando en su propio legado y confiando en su seguridad política. Pero Dios lo despoja de su cargo y eleva a Eliaquim por su fiel administración.

A Pedro se le confiere la autoridad divina —las llaves del Reino— por su fidelidad a Cristo. No es un político refinado, un estratega consumado ni un dictador religioso, sino un pescador impulsivo y frágil. Mientras Sebna labraba su tumba en la roca, Cristo edifica su Iglesia sobre una “Roca”.

Dios no necesita nuestras poses de grandeza, nuestro historial de fortalezas ni los reinos que construimos, sino nuestra entrega. Pedro se convierte en columna porque deja de confiar en su propio poder humano y se abre a la gracia divina. La autoridad proviene de Dios (Juan 19:10-11). El poder se otorga para proteger; la autoridad, para servir.

Si construimos nuestras propias “tumbas al estilo de Sebna”, no comprenderemos la autoridad divina. “¡Qué profunda es la riqueza, la sabiduría y el conocimiento de Dios! Confía tu vida a su autoridad y deja que Él edifique algo eterno sobre el fundamento de un corazón humilde.

Un guante de trabajo vacío yace sobre una mesa. Tiene forma de dedos, pero no puede tomar una herramienta ni moverse por sí solo. Una mano viva se desliza dentro del guante. Ahora el guante puede realizar un trabajo arduo, pero solo porque la mano le da poder y dirección.

Así también, la fuerza humana por sí sola no puede producir nada de valor eterno. La autoridad de Dios actúa mejor cuando permitimos que su Espíritu se mueva a través de nosotros (Isaías 10:15).

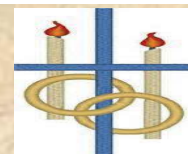

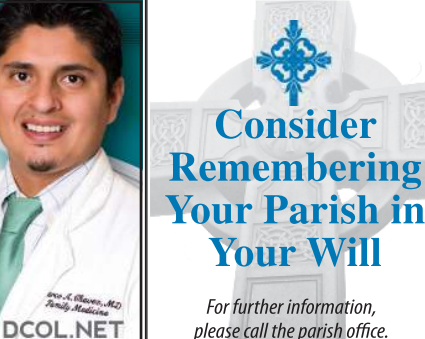
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
