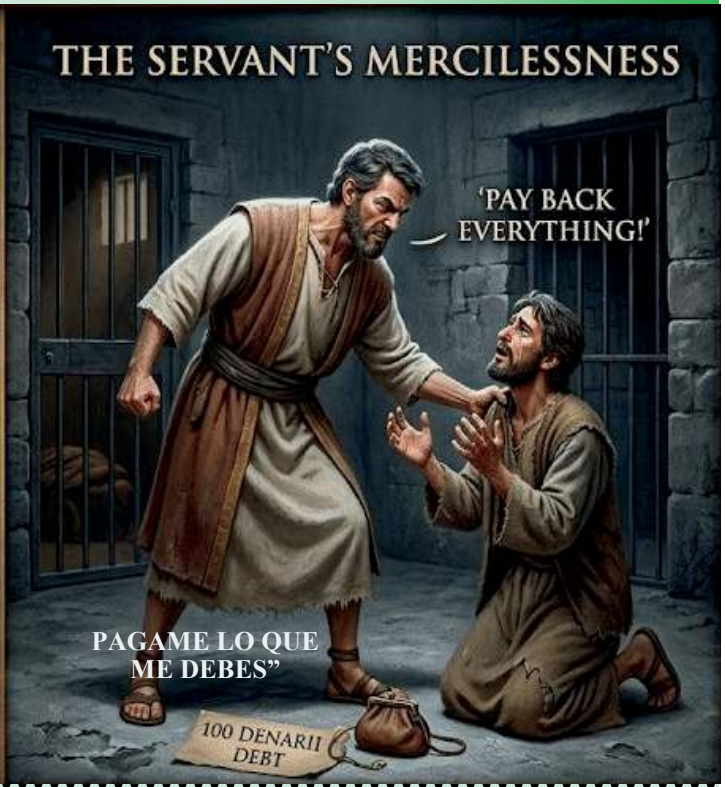
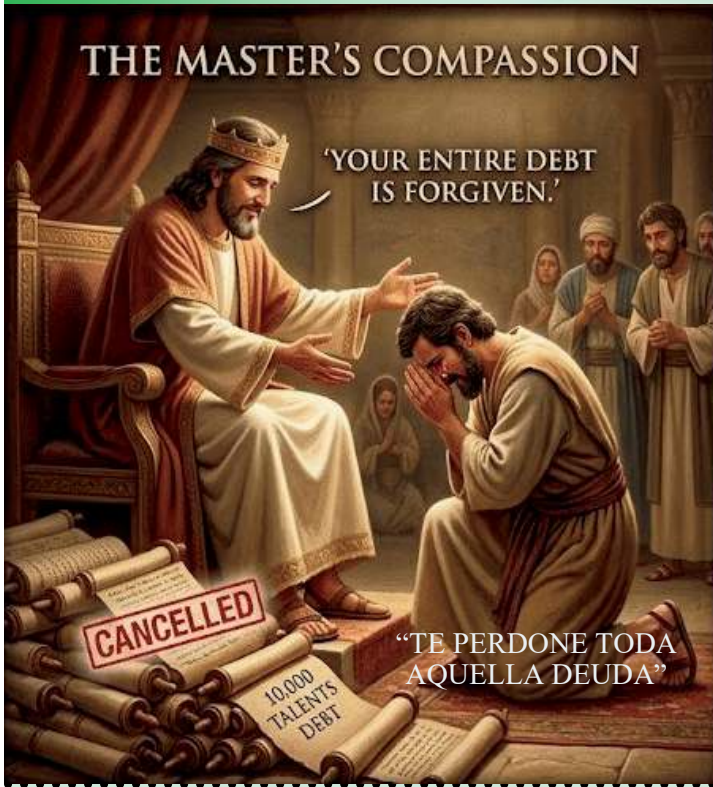

Forgiveness IS For Giving

Dear brothers and sisters,

Forgiveness is not a feeling, but a gift meant to be passed on. The unforgiving servant in the Gospel failed because he forgot the massive mercy he had already received. Forgiveness does not minimize or pretend the hurt never happened.

Instead, it allows grace to step in where justice alone falls short, offering the offender dignity beyond failure.

For many carrying decades-old wounds, manufacturing forgiveness feels impossible. However, the Gospel simply asks us to pass on the compassion and mercy God continuously pours into us. Holding onto resentment is like drinking poison and expecting the other person to die; it shackles your present to someone else's past mistake.

Crucially, forgiveness is not the same as reconciliation. Reconciliation requires mutual trust and two people working together. Forgiveness requires only YOU. You can completely forgive someone to free your own heart, even if it is unsafe to restore the relationship. Ultimately, letting go of anger evicts the person living rent-free in your mind. Forgiveness is giving yourself your life back.

When you refuse to forgive, you hand over your remote control to the person who hurt you, allowing them to dictate your current mood, your energy, and your perspective. Forgiveness is the ultimate act of reclaiming your power.

In October 2006, a gunman shot ten girls at an Amish school in Nickel Mines, Pennsylvania, before killing himself. Astoundingly, the Amish community immediately visited the shooter's family to offer food, comfort, and financial support. By choosing daily forgiveness over bitterness, the Amish prevented hate from destroying their community. To forgive is to set a prisoner free and discover that the prisoner was you. We received, let's give it. Blessings! - Msgr. Xavier

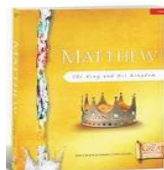

Consider sharing your faith with our children.

"Parents are the most important factor

in the healthy development and faith formation of their children and adolescents!"

Jim Burns has written an article entitled "How to Pass Your Faith to Your Kids." (p. 41) He offers ten practical suggestions for parents to use as they nurture their child's spiritual development:

1. Be yourself.
2. Don't limit your conversations on spiritual matters to Sunday or weekend Mass only.
3. Let your kids see you in the act of doing something spiritual.
4. Look for natural opportunities to raise spiritual issues.
5. Take the posture of a 'fellow-learner' as opposed to that of a 'teacher and student.'
6. Utilize media to launch discussions about God and the Christian life.
7. Have a plan for family devotional and prayer times.
8. Have fun with your kids.
9. Get involved in ministry together as a family.
10. Disciple and equip your kids.

El Perdón ES Para Darlo

Queridos hermanos y hermanas:

El perdón no es un sentimiento, sino un regalo destinado a ser transmitido a los demás. El siervo que no quiso perdonar, mencionado en el Evangelio, fracasó porque olvidó la inmensa misericordia que ya había recibido. El perdón no minimiza el daño ni finge que nunca ocurrió; más bien, permite que la gracia intervenga allí donde la justicia por sí sola resulta insuficiente, ofreciendo al ofensor una dignidad que trasciende su propio error.

Para muchos que cargan con heridas de hace décadas, generar el perdón parece imposible. Sin embargo, el Evangelio simplemente nos pide que transmitamos la compasión y la misericordia que Dios derrama continuamente sobre nosotros. Aferrarse al resentimiento es como beber veneno y esperar que la otra persona muera; encadena tu presente al error pasado de alguien más.

Es fundamental entender que el perdón no es lo mismo que la reconciliación. La reconciliación requiere confianza mutua y la colaboración de dos personas. El perdón, en cambio, depende solo de TI. Puedes perdonar plenamente a alguien para liberar tu propio corazón, incluso si no es seguro restablecer la relación. En última instancia, soltar la ira expulsa a la persona que habita en tu mente sin pagar alquiler. El perdón sirve para devolvarte tu propia vida. Cuando te niegas a perdonar, le entregas el control a quien te hirió, permitiéndole dictar tu estado de ánimo, tu energía y tu perspectiva. El perdón es el acto supremo para recuperar tu propio poder.

En octubre de 2006, un hombre armado disparó contra diez niñas en una escuela amish en Pennsylvania, antes de quitarse la vida. Sorprendentemente, la comunidad amish visitó de inmediato a la familia del agresor para ofrecerles alimentos, consuelo y apoyo económico. Al elegir el perdón diario frente a la amargura, los amish evitaron que el odio destruyera su comunidad. Perdonar es liberar a un prisionero y descubrir que ese prisionero eras tú. Lo hemos recibido; démoslo nosotros también.

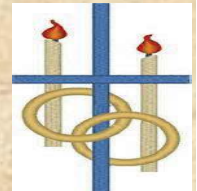
