Gratitude Vs Grumbling

Dear brothers and sisters,

God says, "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways my ways." Jesus' parable of the workers in the vineyard breaks down His words.

A landowner goes out at dawn, at noon, and even at the eleventh hour—just one hour before sunset—to hire laborers. When evening comes, he gives everyone the exact same daily wage. The workers who labored all day received precisely what they agreed to, what they needed, and what was fair. Their problem wasn't poverty; it was perspective. They were so busy staring at someone else's envelope that they lost sight of their own provision. When we nurse a grudge, against a neighbor, a family member, or even against God because life hasn't dealt us the cards we think we deserve, we blind ourselves to the gifts given.

How to remove or heal our grudges and grumbings? God's economy is not driven by wages; it is driven by grace. If God gave us strict "fairness," if He gave us strictly what our sins and impatience deserved, none of us would stand. God stretches His mercy as high as the heavens are above the earth. Therefore, only gratitude cures the covetous eye and softens the hardened, resentful heart.

Shifting from a grudge to gratitude, perspective to provision, and pain to person requires dismantling a mental habit that feels protective in the moment; and intentional, spiritual, and psychological "rewiring". When you know you are fully loved, fully seen, and deeply forgiven by God and others you really feel the blessings and fill your heart and mind with gratitude.

"Gratitude is not only the greatest of virtues but the parent of all others." Let's always have an attitude of gratitude and grumbling will disappear! (Phil 2:14)

Pro-Life: Month 6, Fetal Development

The baby sits erect now to accommodate the growing internal organs as they shift slightly into their proper places. Oil and sweat glands are functioning; these help regulate body temperature. A white filmy layer covers the baby and protects delicate skin from the surrounding amniotic fluid and from scratches as baby twists and turns. This waxy substance will be quickly absorbed into skin soon after birth. Lungs are fairly well developed and would stand a good chance of survival if birth occurs at this time.

2. Don't limit your conversations on spiritual matters to Sunday or weekend Mass only.
3. Let your kids see you in the act of doing something spiritual.
4. Look for natural opportunities to raise spiritual issues.
5. Take the posture of a 'fellow-learner' as opposed to that of a 'teacher and student.'
6. Utilize media to launch discussions about God and the Christian life.
7. Have a plan for family devotional and prayer times.
8. Have fun with your kids.
9. Get involved in ministry together as a family.
10. Disciple and equip your kids.

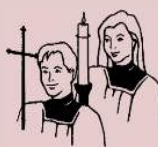

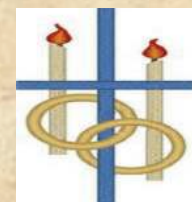
